



international armed conflict. Disciplinary sanctions allowed against EPWs must relate to breaches of camp discipline and can only be imposed by the Camp Commander. Only four types of punishments are authorized. The maximum punishments are:

- a. Fine: 1/2 pay up to 30 days
- b. Withdrawal of privileges, not rights.
- c. 2 hours of fatigue duty per day for 30 days
- d. Confinement for 30 days

Take-Away/Discussion Points

- Sanctions allowed between Prisoners and EPW are regulated and applied similarly.
- In both instances, they are related to the offense committed and imposed by command authority.
