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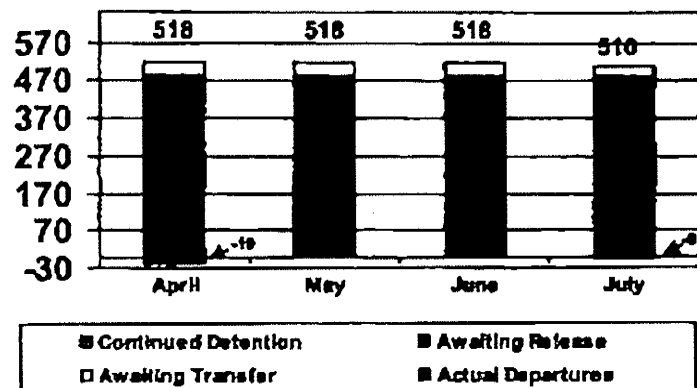
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Guantanamo Detained Enemy Combatants

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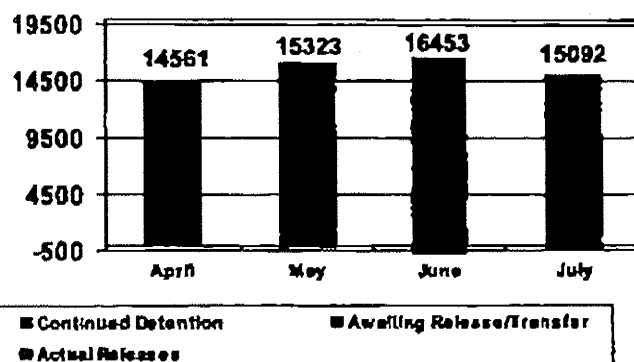


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Iraq Security Internees

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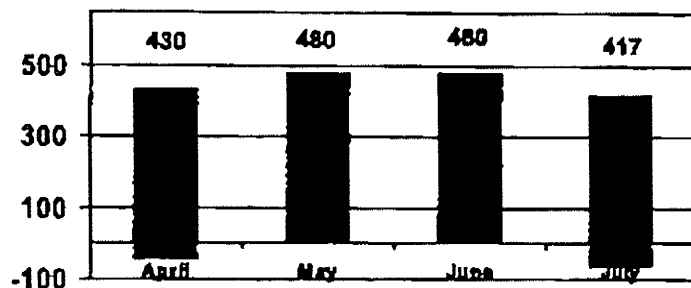


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Afghanistan Detained Enemy Combatants
