IN ORDER TO FURTHER PROTECT THE WOUND, AZ SHOULD BE LAIN IN THE BOX ON HIS BACK, THOUGH SUFFICIENT SPACE SHOULD BE ALLOWED FOR HIM TO TURN

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| ONTO HIS SIDE. |
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| B. AZ'S HAND MOVEMENT SHOULD BE RESTRICTED IN SUCH A WAY AS TO PROHIBIT HIS DISTURBING THE WOUND OR ITS DRESSING. INITIALLY, THERE WAS SOME CONCERN AMONG OMS STAFF THAT AZ WOULD ATTEMPT TO SABOTAGE HIS OWN RECOVERY. INDICATES THAT AZ HAS EXHIBITED NO SIGNS OF WISHING TO HARM HIMSELF.
