SUBJECT ALSO PLACED HIS FEET ABOUT SHOULDER LENGTH APART AND GRASPED THE BARS WITH HIS HANDS TO DO A SERIES OF STANDING PUSH-UPS. HIS ROUTINE INCLUDED BACK, SHOULDER, AND NECK STRETCHING EXERCISES. SUBJECT ACTIVITY INCLUDED SEVERAL SESSIONS OF PRAYER AND SINGING. WHEN SITTING ON HIS PAD, HE CONTINUES TO OCCASIONALLY FINGER HIS NOSE. TOES, AND OTHER APPENDAGES.
