Dear Mr. Wray:

(U//FOUO) I am writing to you pursuant to Title 50 U.S.C. §403q(b)(5) to report information concerning possible violations of federal criminal law.

(S//NF) The Office of Inspector General (OIG) is investigating the facts and circumstances surrounding the death in U.S. custody of Iraqi detainee Manadal Al-Jamaidi. Al-Jamaidi was captured by a Navy Seal Team contingent on 4 November 2003, [Redacted], and died [Redacted]

[Redacted] at Abu Ghurayb prison, near Baghdad. A subsequent autopsy by a Medical Examiner from the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology (AFIP) disclosed Al-Jamaidi suffered six broken ribs and numerous contusions prior to his death. The cause of death was determined to be "blunt force injuries complicated by compromised respiration;" the manner of death was described as homicide.

(U//FOUO) A joint CIA OIG/Army Criminal Investigation Division (CID) investigation is ongoing. I am referring this matter to you now concurrent with the release of the Final Autopsy Report.
