INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

"This is an Operation Iraqi Freedom Investigation"

On 27 Jul 07, this office was notified by CPT (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Battle Captain, 110th Field Artillery (FA), Camp Bucca, APO AE 09375 that Detainee KHALID had died at the 28th Combat Support Hospital (CSH), Balad.

Investigation established probable cause to believe Detainees (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) committed the offenses of Murder and Conspiracy when Detainees (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) sentenced Detainee KHALID to be beaten for infractions of the Islamic religion. The infractions occurred when Detainee KHALID threw bread in the compound latrine. Detainees (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) beat Detainee KHALID about the head, shoulders, abdomen, and legs with closed fists, metal sticks and other unidentified objects. Detainee KHALID was subsequently transported to the Theater Internment Facility (TIF) Hospital, where on 26 Jul 07, he died.

An autopsy conducted by the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology (AFIP) determined the cause of death was from complications from sharp force and blunt force injuries of the head. The manner of death was determined to homicide. The results of this investigation are consistent with that finding.

**BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION:** About 2200, 27 Jul 07, this office was notified by CPT (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Battle Captain, 1-10<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery, Camp Bucca, that Detainee Mu' ammad Q. KHALID, Internment Serial Number (ISN): (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Compound 24B, Theater Internment Facility (TIF), Camp Bucca, had died at the 28<sup>th</sup> Combat Support Hospital (CSH), Balad, Iraq.

About 0830, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) telephonically interviewed Dr. (MAJ) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Attending Physician, 28<sup>th</sup> CSH, Balad, Iraq, who related Detainee KHALID had been transported to 28<sup>th</sup> CSH for further treatment of wounds sustained during an assault in Compound 24B, TIF, Camp Bucca. Dr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated Detainee KHALID suffered a stroke, but he could not determine if it was directly related to the assault. Dr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) further stated Detainee KHALID was intubated and administered medication to sustain his life, which met with negative results. Dr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) related the preliminary cause of death to be Left ICH Ischemic Stroke and the manner of death to be natural causes. Dr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated he pronounced Detainee KHALID dead at 0247, 26 Jul 07.

About 1330, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed CPL (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Headquarters and Headquarters Battery (HHB), 1-10 Field Artillery (FA), Tower NCO, Compound 24B, Camp Bucca, who related he was in Tower 7 when the incident took place and he saw six to eight detainees, wearing masks on their faces, carry Detainee KHALID out of his tent to the entry/exit (E/E) of compound 24B. When the detainees reached the entry way, they threw Detainee KHALID to the ground and started beating him with a stick and a piece of a metal picket. CPL (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) yelled for them to stop, which they did not do. One of the other tower guards fired a small amount of non-lethal rounds at the detainees who beat Detainee KHALID, which met with negative results. Since the small rounds did not work, the tower guards fired three crowd control rounds into the compound to disperse the crowd of about fifty detainees, which had the desired effect. A short time later, between six and eight unmasked men carried Detainee KHALID to the sally port for medical attention. CPL (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) was unaware if the unmasked detainees were involved in the beating.

About 1415, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed PFC (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Headquarters and Headquarters Battery (HHB), 1-10 Field Artillery (FA), Tower Guard, Compound 24B, Camp Bucca, who related he noticed a number of detainees engaged in what he thought was digging, but was actually about seven masked detainees dragging, what appeared to be, an unmasked detainee between tents 22 and 29 in compound 29B. When the masked detainees placed Detainee KHALID in the E/E, PFC (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) saw a detainee kneel down next to Detainee KHALID, while between seven and fifty detainees, who were wearing masks, stood around, watched and eventually struck Detainee KHALID. When CPL (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) shouted for the detainees to stop, PFC (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) saw what appeared to be a metal picket type device rise up into the air and was swung back down toward the ground, striking Detainee KHALID, causing him shout to out in great pain. A short time later, 6 to 8 unmasked detainees carried Detainee KHALID to the gate of the compound. PFC (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) further related he was uncertain if the 6 to 8 unmasked detainees were involved with the beating.

AGENTS COMMENT: Several searches by the Quick Reaction Force (QRF) of the compound had been conducted and none of the items described by PFC (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) were recovered.

About 1430, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) this office, requested Compound 24B provide a list of all detainees who have transferred out of the compound since the incident by 1900, 28 Jul 07.

About 1440, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Category 2 Linguist, L-3 Titan, this office, interviewed Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Compound 24B Linguist, reference any knowledge he had of the incident. Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) related when Detainee KHALID exited the compound after the beating, he stated Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and other detainees had beat him.

AGENTS COMMENT: The name (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) was a nickname. There was no detainee by this name in the compound.

About 1830, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) obtained the list of detainees who have moved from Compound 24B since the incident. Detainees (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) and (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) were moved to Compound 3 and Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) was moved to Compound 8.

About 1845, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (Nickname (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) the compound chief. Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) related Detainee KHALID was beat for disrespecting their religion by throwing his bread and rice in the latrine. He would not assist in the identification of who beat Detainee KHALID.

About 1930, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Nothing pertaining to this investigation was discovered.

About 2045, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) identified Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) as being (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) was the head judge of the Shariyat Court which sentenced Detainee KHALID to the beating for being a magician and disrespecting the religion. Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) also assisted in the beating of Detainee KHALID. Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) further related Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) may be of assistance in this investigation. Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) was moved to protective custody for further interview.

About 2200, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) further identified Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) as being (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)

About 0100, 29 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) who requested to speak with this office. Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) related he and Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) witnessed the beating but were afraid to speak while still in the compound. Both detainees were moved to protective custody for further interview.

CRIME SCENE (Verification) EXAMINATION: Between 0800 and 0900, 29 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) conducted a crime scene verification examination of Compound 24B, TIF, Camp Bucca.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE SCENE: Compound 24B is constructed of metal and canvass type construction "Hesko" barriers, filled with sand, with concertina wire placed on the top. Enclosed inside the compound is an open area used for exercise type activities adjacent to the South wall which is enclosed with Hesko barriers which run the width of the compound. In the area between the dividing wall and the North wall there was a group of green and grey in color, canvas type construction tents, measuring approximately 10 feet wide by 20 feet long, which were inhabited by numerous detainees. There was one main Entry/Exit way (E/E) to the compound. The E/E was located in the Southwest corner of the compound. Compound 24B is surrounded by Compound 23 to the west, an unfinished compound to the east, and the main portion of the TIF to the north, and the main access road to the south.

CONDITIONS OF THE SCENE: Compound 24B appeared to be lived in. There were a total of twenty-one tents constructed within the compound, neatly arranged in three rows with seven tents in each row. Each tent had a number between 22 and 42 painted on each in red in color paint. There were several detainees inside the tents sleeping and a small number of detainees outside the tents walking around.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS: At the time of the crime scene examination, the outside temperature was approximately 110 degrees Fahrenheit and the examination was conducted during hours of daylight.

FACTORS PERTINENT TO ENTRY AND/EXIT: Access to the compound could be gained through the one E/E on the South wall, in the southwest corner of the compound. Access to Compound 24B could be gained through a gate (sally port) on the south side of the compound. A corridor leading to the E/E was constructed of concertina wire in the northwest corner of the compound. The compound was enclosed by Hesko type barriers and concertina wire.

SCENE DOCUMENTATION: SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) exposed digital photographs of the crime scene using a Nikon Coolpix 995 digital camera and SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) drafted a crime scene sketch. (See photographic packet and crime scene sketch for details)

AGENT'S COMMENTS: About 0845, 29 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) attempted to prepare a complete crime scene examination of Compound 24B, TIF, Camp Bucca; however, due to a lack of security within the TIF compounds, a crime scene examination was unable to be thoroughly completed. Approximately 400 detainees, most of whom are detained for violent acts against coalition forces, reside in the essentially autonomous compound. Compound security forces infrequently enter the compound and much of the administration of daily happenings rests with the detainee leaders. A security force of adequate size was not available to provide security; therefore, all documentation was completed from guard tower 5 and guard tower 7 of Compound 24B.

About 0900, 30 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) related what he observed the day of the incident. (See English Language Translation of Statement of Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) for details)

About 1030, 30 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) related what he observed the day of the incident. 

## DETAILS

**BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION:** About 2320, 27 Jul 07, this office was notified by SSG (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Mortuary Affairs Office, 54th Quartermaster CO, 240th Quartermaster BN, Logistical Support Area Anaconda, Balad, Iraq APO AE 09391 (LSAA) that the Camp Bucca CID office requested this office to obtain photographs of Mr. KHALID, who had died from injuries sustained at Camp Bucca.

Between 0018 and 0045, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) exposed digital photographs of Mr. KHALID's remains, using a Nikon Coolpix 995-camera.

About 0050, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) coordinated with SSG (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) to obtain the medical treatment records pertaining to Mr. KHALID. SSG (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) provided this office with copies of the TF 30<sup>th</sup> Medical BDE CCIR Report including the Authorization and Treatment Statement Form, Hospital Report of Death Form, Chronological Record of Medical Care Form, and Multi-National Forces-Iraq Form pertaining to Mr. KHALID.

About 0110, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) coordinated with MAJ (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Night OIC, Patient Administration Department, Air Force Theater Hospital, 332nd Expeditionary Medical Group (EMDG), LSAA to obtain the medical treatment record pertaining to Mr. KHALID. MAJ (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) provided this office with copies of the Patient Treatment Management records pertaining to medical treatments Mr. KHALID received.

About 0121, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed (DR) MAJ (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Air Force Theater Hospital, 332nd EMDG, LSAA regarding his observations of Mr. KHALID and the treatment rendered to Mr. KHALID. MAJ (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated that Mr. KHALID had what appeared to be blunt force trauma to the head. His left side of his brain had a stroke that could have been cause by blunt force to his neck or brain. His right ulna had an open fracture and his left metacarpals (fingers) were fractured. MAJ (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated he ordered IV fluids, antibiotics such as ancef and levaquin, and pain relief in the form of morphine. Mr. KHALID had a very low and altered mental status and could only respond to physical stimulus to the right side of his body. Also, his left eye had been removed. All of the treatments rendered to Mr. KHALID were only measures of comfort as his prognosis was that he would not survive. Mr. KHALID had continual swelling to his brain and after MAJ (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) conducted a life signs exams which were negative he pronounced him dead at 0247, 26 Jul 07.

**AGENT'S COMMENT:** MAJ (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) was not present when life saving measures were taking place. He was only called in afterward to conduct a life signs exam of Mr. KHALID and pronounce him dead.

About 0940, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) coordinated with SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Camp Bucca CID, and briefed him all aspects of the RFA. SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated no further investigative assistance of this office would be required.///Last Entry///

**VOLATILES:** The **BLOOD AND VITREOUS FLUID** were examined for the presence of ethanol at a cutoff of 20 mg/dL. No ethanol was detected.

**CYANIDE:** There was no cyanide detected in the blood. The limit of quantitation for cyanide is 0.25 mg/L. Normal blood cyanide concentrations are less than 0.15 mg/L. Lethal concentrations of cyanide are greater than 3 mg/L.

**DRUGS:** The **URINE** was screened for acetaminophen, amphetamine, antidepressants, antihistamines, barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cannabinoids, chloroquine, cocaine, dextromethorphan, lidocaine, narcotic analgesics, opiates, phenacyclidine, phenothiazines, salicylates, sympathomimetic amines and verapamil by gas chromatography, color test or immunoassay. **Circumstances of Death:** This 31 year-old civilian was being detained at the Theater Internment Facility (TIF) at Camp Bucca, Iraq when, as reported, he was assaulted by unknown detainee(s) on 24 JUL 2007. He was transported to the TIF hospital for treatment and transferred to the 28<sup>th</sup> Combat Support Hospital for further treatment. On 26 JUL 2007 he began to exhibit signs and symptoms of a stroke and was intubated.

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**EXTERNAL EXAMINATION**

The body is that of a well-developed, well-nourished male. The body is 70 inches in length, weighs 211 pounds, and appears compatible with the stated age of 31 years old. The body is cold. Lividity is fixed on the posterior surface of the body except in the areas exposed to pressure. Rigor is resolving and equal in the upper and lower extremities.

Injuries are described in "Evidence of Injury". The scalp hair is black and short. The facial hair consists of a black beard. A plastic cap covers the left eye and injury of the left eye precludes assessment. The right iris is indistinct. The right cornea is cloudy. The right conjunctiva is congested and the right sclera is hemorrhagic. The teeth are natural. On the anterior scalp is a 2-inch linear scar. A 1/2 x 1/2-inch nevus is on the bridge of the nose.

The chest is symmetric. The hair of the upper left side of the chest is shaved. A 4-inch linear scar is on the right lower quadrant of the abdomen. The genitalia are those of an adult circumcised male. The anus is unremarkable.

The upper and lower extremities are symmetric. The fingernails are intact. The soles of the feet are callous. On the left upper extremity are multiple scars in various stages of healing ranging in size from 4 x 1/4-inch to 2 x 1-inch. On the lateral right hip are six, 1/8-inch in maximum dimension, skin defects. There are multiple healed scars on both knees that are 1/4-inch in maximum dimension. A scar is on the anterior left foot that is 3/4-inch in maximum dimension.

The body is unclad and no personal effects are present with the body.

**MEDICAL INTERVENTION**

On the right side of the scalp is a 1/8-inch defect that is secured by two metal staples. This defect correlates with a 3 millimeter defect in the calvarium and a 3 millimeter defect in the dura mater (consistent with trephine). There is gauze over the left eye. Both upper eyelids and the right lower eyelid have sutures (see "Evidence of Injury".) On the upper left side of the chest is a puncture mark. A 5-1/2-inch incision closed with staples is on the posterior right forearm. On the left groin are two, 1/8-inch incisions (consistent with vascular access cut downs).

**RADIOGRAPHS**

A complete set of post-mortem radiographs is obtained and demonstrate fractures of both medial walls of the orbits, staples in the scalp, and fracture of the ulna with associated plate and screw fixation and overlying skin staples.

On the upper and lower right eyelids are obliquely oriented, 1-inch in length penetrating sharp force wounds (sutured). 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The thyroid gland is symmetric and red-brown, without cystic or nodular change. The larynx is lined by intact white mucosa. The tongue is unremarkable.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM:

The upper airway is clear of debris and foreign material. The mucosal surfaces are smooth, yellow-tan and unremarkable. The right and left lungs weigh 1050 and 810 grams, respectively. 5. Acetaminophen was detected in the urine. The blood contained 6.3 mg/L of acetaminophen.

**OPINION**

This 31 year-old male, Muhammed Qusay Khalid, died of complications of sharp and blunt force injuries of the head. He had penetrating sharp force injuries of both eyes. The left optic nerve was transected and there were fractures of the orbital walls that extended into the sphenoid sinus. In addition, he had subarachnoid hemorrhage and contusions of the left side of the brain. Gross examination and microscopic sections of the brainstem revealed hemorrhages of the midline that are consistent with herniation. The results of the toxicology screen are consistent with resuscitative efforts. The manner of death is homicide.

Internal examination reveals a 2 x 1-inch contusion of the left temporalis muscle. There is diffuse subarachnoid hemorrhage and contusions of the left frontal and parietal lobes of the brain. **OPINION**

This 31 year-old male (b)(6) died of complications of sharp and blunt force injuries of the head. He had penetrating sharp force injuries of both eyes. The left optic nerve was transected and there were fractures of the orbital walls that extended into the sphenoid sinus. In addition, he had subarachnoid hemorrhage and contusions of the left side of the brain. Gross examination and microscopic sections of the brainstem revealed hemorrhages of the midline that are consistent with herniation. The results of the toxicology screen are consistent with resuscitative efforts. The manner of death is homicide.
