INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

"This is an Operation Iraqi Freedom Investigation"

On 27 Jul 07, this office was notified by CPT (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Battle Captain, 110th Field Artillery (FA), Camp Bucca, APO AE 09375 that Detainee KHALID had died at the 28th Combat Support Hospital (CSH), Balad.

An autopsy conducted by the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology (AFIP) determined the cause of death was from complications from sharp force and blunt force injuries of the head. The manner of death was determined to homicide. The results of this investigation are consistent with that finding.

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: About 2200, 27 Jul 07, this office was notified by CPT (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Battle Captain, 1-10th Field Artillery, Camp Bucca, that Detainee Mu¹.1mmad Q. KHALID, Internment Serial Number (ISN): ^{(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)}Compound 24B, Theater Internment Facility (TIF), Camp Bucca, had died at the 28th Combat Support Hospital (CSH), Balad, Iraq.

About 0830, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) telephonically interviewed Dr. (MAJ) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Attending Physician, 28th CSH, Balad, Iraq, who related Detainee KHALID had been transported to 28th CSH for further treatment of wounds sustained during an assault in Compound 24B, TIF, Camp Bucca. Dr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated Detainee KHALID suffered a stroke, but he could not determine if it was directly related to the assault. Dr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) further stated Detainee KHALID was intubated and administered medication to sustain his life, which met with negative results. Dr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) related the preliminary cause of death to be Left ICH Ischemic Stroke and the manner of death to be natural causes. Dr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated he pronounced Detainee KHALID dead at 0247, 26 Jul 07.

About 1330, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed CPL (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Headquarters and Headquarters Battery (HHB), 1-10 Field Artillery (FA), Tower NCO, Compound 24B, Camp Bucca, who related he was in Tower 7 when the incident took place and he saw six to eight detainees, wearing masks on their faces, carry Detainee KHALID out of his tent to the entry/exit (E/E) of compound 24B. When the detainees reached the entry way, they threw Detainee KHALID to the ground and started beating him with a stick and a piece of a metal picket. CPL (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) yelled for them to stop, which they did not do. One of the other tower guards fired a small amount of non-lethal rounds at the detainees who beat Detainee KHALID, which met with negative results. Since the small rounds did not work, the tower guards fired three crowd control rounds into the compound to disperse the crowd of about fifty detainees, which had the desired effect. A short time later, between six and eight unmasked men carried Detainee KHALID to the sally port for medical attention. CPL (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) was unaware if the unmasked detainees were involved in the beating.

About 0100, 29 Jul 07, SA and Mr. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) interviewed Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (ISN who requested to speak with this office. Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) related he and Detainee (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) witnessed the beating but were afraid to speak while still in the compound. Both detainees were moved to protective custody for further interview.

CRIME SCENE (Verification) EXAMINATION: Between 0800 and 0900, 29 Jul 07, SA((b)(6), (b)(7)(C) conducted a crime scene verification examination of Compound 24B, TIF, Camp Bucca.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE SCENE: Compound 24B is constructed of metal and canvass type construction "Hesko" barriers, filled with sand, with concertina wire placed on the top. Enclosed inside the compound is an open area used for exercise type activities adjacent to the South wall which is enclosed with Hesko barriers which run the width of the compound. In the area between the dividing wall and the North wall there was a group of green and grey in color, canvas type construction tents, measuring approximately 10 feet wide by 20 feet long, which were inhabited by numerous detainees. There was one main Entry/Exit way (E/E) to the compound. The E/E was located in the Southwest corner of the compound. Compound 24B is surrounded by Compound 23 to the west, an unfinished compound to the east, and the main portion of the TIF to the north, and the main access road to the south.

CONDITIONS OF THE SCENE: Compound 24B appeared to be lived in. There were a total of twenty-one tents constructed within the compound, neatly arranged in three rows with seven tents in each row. Each tent had a number between 22 and 42 painted on each in red in color paint. There were several detainees inside the tents sleeping and a small number of detainees outside the tents walking around.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS: At the time of the crime scene examination, the outside temperature was approximately 110 degrees Fahrenheit and the examination was conducted during hours of daylight.

FACTORS PERTINENT TO ENTRY AND/EXIT: Access to the compound could be gained through the one E/E on the South wall, in the southwest corner of the compound. Access to Compound 24B could be gained through a gate (sally port) on the south side of the compound. A corridor leading to the E/E was constructed of concertina wire in the northwest corner of the compound. The compound was enclosed by Hesko type barriers and concertina wire.

SCENE DOCUMENTATION: $SA^{(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)}_{(c)}$ exposed digital photographs of the crime scene using a Nikon Coolpix 995 digital camera and $SA^{(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)}_{(c)}$ drafted a crime scene sketch. (See photographic packet and crime scene sketch for details)

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: About 2320, 27 Jul 07, this office was notified by SSG(b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Mortuary Affairs Office, 54th Quartermaster CO, 240th Quartermaster BN, Logistical Support Area Anaconda, Balad, Iraq APO AE 09391 (LSAA) that the Camp Bucca CID office requested this office to obtain photographs of Mr. KHALID, who had died from injuries sustained at Camp Bucca.

Between 0018 and 0045, 28 Jul 07, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) exposed digital photographs of Mr. KHALID's remains, using a Nikon Coolpix 995-camera.

About 0050, 28 Jul 07, SA(b)(6), (b)(7)(C) coordinated with SSG^(Corocce) to obtain the medical treatment records pertaining to Mr. KHALID. SSG^(Corocce) provided this office with copies of the TF 30th Medical BDE CCIR Report including the Authorization and Treatment Statement Form, Hospital Report of Death Form, Chronological Record of Medical Care Form, and Multi-National Forces-Iraq Form pertaining to Mr. KHALID.

His right ulna had an open fracture and his left metacarpals (fingers) were fractured. MAJ bio, (b)(7)(C) stated he ordered IV fluids, antibiotics such as ancef and levaquin, and pain relief in the form of morphine. Mr. KHALID had a very low and altered mental status and could only respond to physical stimulus to the right side of his body. Also, his left eye had been removed. All of the treatments rendered to Mr. KHALID were only measures of comfort as his prognosis was that he would not survive. Mr. KHALID had continual swelling to his brain and after MAJ he pronounced him dead at 0247, 26 Jul 07.

AGENT'S COMMENT: MAJ^{600,0070C} was not present when life saving measures were taking place. He was only called in afterward to conduct a life signs exam of Mr. KHALID and pronounce him dead.

DRUGS: The **URINE** was screened for acetaminophen, amphetamine, antidepressants, antihistamines, barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cannabinoids, chloroquine, cocaine, dextromethorphan, lidocaine, narcotic analgesics, opiates, phencyclidine, phenothiazines, salicylates, sympathomimetic amines and verapamil by gas chromatography, color test or immunoassay. EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

The body is that of a well-developed, well-nourished male. The body is 70 inches in length, weighs 211 pounds, and appears compatible with the stated age of 31 years old. The body is cold. Lividity is fixed on the posterior surface of the body except in the areas exposed to pressure. Rigor is resolving and equal in the upper and lower extremities.

Injuries are described in "Evidence of Injury". The scalp hair is black and short. The facial hair consists of a black beard. A plastic cap covers the left eye and injury of the left eye precludes assessment. The right iris is indistinct. The right cornea is cloudy. The right conjunctiva is congested and the right sclera is hemorrhagic. The teeth are natural. On the anterior scalp is a 2-inch linear scar. A $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$ -inch nevus is on the bridge of the nose.

The chest is symmetric. The hair of the upper left side of the chest is shaved. A 4-inch linear scar is on the right lower quadrant of the abdomen. The genitalia are those of an adult circumcised male. The anus is unremarkable.

The upper and lower extremities are symmetric. The fingernails are intact. The soles of the feet are callous. On the left upper extremity are multiple scars in various stages of healing ranging in size from $4 \times \frac{1}{4}$ -inch to 2×1 -inch. On the lateral right hip are six, 1/8-inch in maximum dimension, skin defects. There are multiple healed scars on both knees that are $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch in maximum dimension. A scar is on the anterior left foot that is $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch in maximum dimension.

CLOTHING AND PERSONAL EFFECTS

The body is unclad and no personal effects are present with the body.

MEDICAL INTERVENTION

On the right side of the scalp is a 1/8-inch defect that is secured by two metal staples. This defect correlates with a 3 millimeter defect in the calvarium and a 3 millimeter defect in the dura mater (consistent with trephine). There is gauze over the left eye. Both upper eyelids and the right lower eyelid have sutures (see "Evidence of Injury".) On the upper left side of the chest is a puncture mark. A 5-1/2-inch incision closed with staples is on the posterior right forearm. On the left groin are two, 1/8-inch incisions (consistent with vascular access cut downs).

RADIOGRAPHS

A complete set of post-mortem radiographs is obtained and demonstrate fractures of both medial walls of the orbits, staples in the scalp, and fracture of the ulna with associated plate and screw fixation and overlying skin staples.

EVIDENCE OF INJURY

I. Head and neck:

On the upper and lower right eyelids are obliquely oriented, 1-inch in length penetrating sharp force wounds (sutured). The underlying medial extra-ocular muscles of the eye have been incised and there are fractures of the medial wall of the right orbit (radiographic). On the upper left eyelid are two obliquely oriented penetrating sharp force wounds (sutured) that are ½-inch and 1-inch in length. The underlying eyeball is ruptured and the extra-ocular muscles are incised.

The thyroid gland is symmetric and red-brown, without cystic or nodular change. The larynx is lined by intact white mucosa. The tongue is unremarkable.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM:

The upper airway is clear of debris and foreign material. The mucosal surfaces are smooth, yellow-tan and unremarkable. The right and left lungs weigh 1050 and 810 grams, respectively. The pulmonary parenchyma is diffusely congested and edematous, exuding moderate amounts of blood and frothy fluid. No mass lesions or areas of consolidation are present. The pulmonary arteries are normally developed and patent without thrombus or embolus.

CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM:

The heart weighs 380 grams and is contained in an intact pericardial sac. The coronary arteries are widely patent. The atrial and ventricular septum are intact. The cardiac valves are unremarkable. The left interventricular septum measures 1.5 centimeters and the left ventricular free wall measures 1.4 centimeters. The right ventricular free wall is 0.3 centimeters thick. The right ventricle is dilated. The aorta and its major branches arise normally and follow the usual course and are unremarkable. The vena cava and its major tributaries return to the heart in the usual distribution and are free of thrombi.

LIVER & BILIARY SYSTEM:

The 1630 gram liver has an intact, smooth capsule and a sharp anterior border. The parenchyma is pale with the usual lobular architecture. No mass lesions or other abnormalities are seen. The gallbladder contains 15 milliliters of green bile. The extrahepatic biliary tree is patent.

SPLEEN:

The 200 gram spleen has a smooth, intact, red-purple capsule. The parenchyma is maroon with unremarkable lymphoid follicles.

PANCREAS:

The pancreas is red-tan. No mass lesions or other abnormalities are seen.

ADRENALS:

The right and left adrenal glands are symmetric, with bright yellow cortices and redbrown medullae. No masses or areas of hemorrhage are identified.

GENITOURINARY SYSTEM:

The right and left kidneys weigh 150 and 170 grams, respectively. The external surfaces are intact and smooth. The cortex is sharply delineated from the medullary pyramids. The pelves are unremarkable and the ureters are normal in course and caliber. The bladder contains 150 milliliters of yellow urine. The prostate and testes are unremarkable.

GASTROINTESTINAL TRACT:

The esophagus is intact and lined by smooth, grey-white mucosa. The stomach, small bowel, and colon are unremarkable. The stomach contains 60 milliliters of brown fluid. The appendix is absent.

MUSCULOSKELETAL:

See "Evidence of Injury". Muscle development is normal. No non-traumatic bone or joint abnormalities are identified.

OPINION

This 31 year-old male, Muhammed Qusay Khalid, died of complications of sharp and blunt force injuries of the head. He had penetrating sharp force injuries of both eyes. The left optic nerve was transected and there were fractures of the orbital walls that extended into the sphenoid sinus. In addition, he had subarachnoid hemorrhage and contusions of the left side of the brain. Gross examination and microscopic sections of the brainstem revealed hemorrhages of the midline that are consistent with herniation. The results of the toxicology screen are consistent with resuscitative efforts. The manner of death is homicide.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

The body is that of a well-developed, well-nourished male. The body is 70 inches in length, weighs 211 pounds, and appears compatible with the stated age of 31 years old. The body is cold. Lividity is fixed on the posterior surface of the body except in the areas exposed to pressure. Rigor is resolving and equal in the upper and lower extremities.

Injuries are described in "Evidence of Injury". The scalp hair is black and short. The facial hair consists of a black beard. A plastic cap covers the left eye and injury of the left eye precludes assessment. The right iris is indistinct. The right cornea is cloudy. The right conjunctiva is congested and the right sclera is hemorrhagic. The teeth are natural. On the anterior scalp is a 2-inch linear scar. A $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$ -inch nevus is on the bridge of the nose.

The chest is symmetric. The hair of the upper left side of the chest is shaved. A 4-inch linear scar is on the right lower quadrant of the abdomen. The genitalia are those of an adult circumcised male. The anus is unremarkable.

The upper and lower extremities are symmetric. The fingernails are intact. The soles of the feet are callous. On the left upper extremity are multiple scars in various stages of healing ranging in size from 4×4 -inch to 2×1 -inch. On the lateral right hip are six, 1/8-inch in maximum dimension, skin defects. There are multiple healed scars on both knees that are 4-inch in maximum dimension. A scar is on the anterior left foot that is 4-inch in maximum dimension.

CLOTHING AND PERSONAL EFFECTS

The body is unclad and no personal effects are present with the body.

MEDICAL INTERVENTION

On the right side of the scalp is a 1/8-inch defect that is secured by two metal staples. This defect correlates with a 3 millimeter defect in the calvarium and a 3 millimeter defect in the dura mater (consistent with trephine). There is gauze over the left eye. Both upper eyelids and the right lower eyelid have sutures (see "Evidence of Injury".) On the upper left side of the chest is a puncture mark. A 5-1/2-inch incision closed with staples is on the posterior right forearm. On the left groin are two, 1/8-inch incisions (consistent with vascular access cut downs).

RADIOGRAPHS

A complete set of post-mortem radiographs is obtained and demonstrate fractures of both medial walls of the orbits, staples in the scalp, and fracture of the ulna with associated plate and screw fixation and overlying skin staples.

EVIDENCE OF INJURY

I. Head and neck:

On the upper and lower right eyelids are obliquely oriented, 1-inch in length penetrating sharp force wounds (sutured). The underlying medial extra-ocular muscles of the eye have been incised and there are fractures of the medial wall of the right orbit (radiographic). There are fractures of the medial wall of the left orbit extending into the sphenoid sinus (radiographic) with associated hemorrhage of the sphenoid sinus. The left optic nerve is transected. There is ecchymosis of the upper and lower left eyelids. On the right cheek is a $\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{4}$ -inch abrasion.

On the left side of the neck, inferior to the left ear, is a $1 \times \frac{1}{2}$ -inch contusion. There is a $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$ -inch contusion of the left earlobe.
