This investigation was initiated upon notification by MAJ [REDACTED] (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Medical Doctor (MD) [REDACTED] (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) 344th Med Field Hospital, Baghdad Central Confinement Facility (BCCF), Abu Ghraib, Iraq (IZ), that a detainee had died at the hospital.

Investigation revealed EMAD had arrived at the 344th Field Hospital suffering from gunshot injuries. According to MAJ [REDACTED] (b)(6),(b)(7)(C), all life saving measures were unsuccessful and EMAD was pronounced dead at 1554, 22 Aug 05. The cause of death was multi-system organ failure resulting from gunshot wounds to the abdomen, left shoulder and left hip.

Further investigation revealed EMAD received his injuries as a result of a combat altercation with U.S. Forces. The Final Autopsy Report listed the Cause of Death as Complications from Gunshot Wounds and the Manner of Death as Homicide. Therefore, his manner of death is listed as combat related.
