for surgery to correct a non-reducible hernia. In addition, RAKAD had a pre-existing congestive
heart condition. Between 17 Dec 05 to 18 Dec 05, RAKAD suffered heart failure six times and
on 18 Dec 05, RAKAD died a natural death as a result of Sepsis due to Bilateral Lobar
Pneumonia due to recent Inguinal Hernia Surgery.

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION

About 1930, 18 Dec 05, this office was notified by Patient Administration Division (PAD), 344th Field Medical Hospital, Baghdad Central Confinement Facility (BCCF), Abu Ghraib, Iraq (AGI), that a detainee had died at the hospital.

About 1935, 18 Dec 05, SA **b(6), b(7)(C)** verified and photographed the body of Detainee Internment Serial Number (ISN) **b(6), b(7)(C)** Hassan H. RAKAD. (See Photographic Packet and Compact Disc for details)

About 1945, 18 Dec 05, SA **b(6), b(7)(C)** interviewed MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** Medical Doctor, General Surgeon, 344th Field Medical Hospital, BCCF, AGI, MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** related the detainee had arrived on 18 Nov 05, for surgery for a hernia. According to MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** the detainee was suffering from congestive heart failure, and developed pneumonia and renal failure after his surgery. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** said the detainee had suffered cardiac arrest six times in the last two days. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** related the detainee suffered cardiac arrest about 1800, 18 Dec 05, and died despite life-saving measures being initiated by Emergency Trauma Room (ETR) staff. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated there were no signs of trauma and nothing unusual was noted. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** related the life saving measures consisted of injections of atropine, calcium, ephedrine, defibrillation and Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) was conducted throughout. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** pronounced death at 1820, 18 Dec 05, with a cause of death of Adult Respiratory Distress Syndrome, with the complications of pneumonia, renal failure and congestive heart failure. At the conclusion of the interview, MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** provided a copy of the detainee's medical records and death certificate. (See Medical Records and Death Certificate for details)

About 2100, 18 Dec 05, SA **b(6), b(7)(C)** obtained the Personal Data Report (PDR) pertaining to 176552 from the Biometric Automated Toolset System (BATS), Inprocessing Holding Area (IHA), BCCF, AGI which identified the detainee as Hassan Hadan RAKAD. (See PDR for details)//LAST ENTRY///



About 1200, 22 Dec 05, the autopsy of BTB Hassan Hadan RAKAD (ME 05-1190) was conducted by Dr. (LCDR) **b(6), b(7)(C)** USN, Medical Corps, Armed Forces Institute of Pathology (AFIP), 1414 Research Blvd., Building 102, Rockville, MD 20850. The preliminary Cause of Death was opined as Sepsis due to Bilateral Lobar Pneumonia due to recent Hernia Surgery and the Manner of Death was opined as Natural. Photographers from AFIP exposed digital photographs of the autopsy and prepared a compact disk containing all images exposed. A copy of the compact disk (CD) containing those images was obtained. Latent Print Examiners of the Latent Print Unit, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Quantico, VA, obtained a ten-block fingerprint card and palm prints of BTB RAKAD and subsequently provided copies to SA **b(6), b(7)(C)** (See PAD, CD and Fingerprint Cards)


