INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

"This is an operation Iraqi Freedom Investigation"

The Military Police, Camp Cropper, Baghdad, Iraq, APO AE 09342 (CCBI) reported an attended death of a detainee at the 21st Combat Support Hospital (CSH), CCBI.

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Investigation disclosed Mr. ATIAH was admitted to the 21st CSH after suffering a heart attack where he was treated from 26 Nov to 2 Dec 06 for atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease. On 2 Dec 06, Mr. ATIAH suffered a heart attack during treatment and died as a result. An autopsy was conducted and determined the cause of death was acute myocardial infarction (heart attack) and the manner of death was natural. The findings of this investigation are consistent with that opinion.

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BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: About 1055, 2 Dec 06, the 324th Military Police, Camp Cropper, Baghdad, Iraq, APO AE 09342 (CCBI) notified this office of a detainee death of Mr. KHALIFAH HAMADI ATIAH, Internment Serial Number (ISN) b(6), b(7)(C) at the 21st Combat Support Hospital (CSH), CCBI, which occurred about 0952, 2 Dec 06.

About 1100, 2 Dec 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) this office, interviewed Dr. (CPT) b(6), b(7)(C) b(6), b(7)(C) Emergency Room Physician, 21" CSH, CCBI. Dr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated that on 27 Nov 06, Mr. ATIAH was brought to the CSH after complaining of chest pains and it was determined after examination that he experienced an acute myocardial infarction (heart attack). Dr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated that Mr. ATIAH was later admitted and received treatment over the next few days. Dr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated that on 2 Dec 06, Mr. ATIAH's condition worsened when his blood pressure dropped and he became unresponsive. Life saving measures were administered to Mr. ATIAH but all efforts to resuscitate him were unsuccessful. Mr. ATIAH was pronounced dead by Dr. b(6), b(7)(C) at 0951, 2 Dec 06. Mr. ATIAH was prescribed Plavix, Lovenox, Metoprolol, Lisinopril, Zocor, and Nitroglycerin. At the time of Mr. ATIAH's death, he was being processed for release as a "Detainee" under compassionate considerations, but had yet to be approved.

About 1110, 2 Dec 06, SAb(6), b(7)(C) this office, verified and photographed the body of Mr. ATIAH. (See Photographic Packet and Compact Disc)

About 1120, 2 Dec 06, SAb(6), b(7)(C) obtained copies of medical records and the preliminary death certificate pertaining to Mr. ATIAH. (See Medical Records and Death Certificate)

About 1130, 2 Dec 06, SA obtained the Personal Data Report (PDR) pertaining to Mr. ATIAH from the Biometrics Automated Toolset System (BATS), confirming the identity of Mr. ATIAH.

About 1150, 2 Dec 06, SAb(6), b(7)(C) Forensic Science Officer, 22nd MP Bn (CID), Camp Victory, IZ, APO AE 09342, coordinated this investigation with Ms.b(6), b(7)(C) Office of the Armed Forces Medical Examiner, Bethesda, MD, who related there would be an autopsy on Mr. KHALIFAH HAMADI ATIAH as he as a detainee at the time of his death.

About 1320, 2 Dec 06, SAb(6), b(7)(C) reviewed the medical records of Mr. KHALIFAH HAMADI ATIAH which failed to reveal anything of evidentiary value.



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DETAILS

Basis for investigation: SA b(6), b(7)(C) received a request for assistance from SA b(6), b(7)(C) 22nd MP BN (CID), Camp Cropper, Iraq, APO AE 09342, to attend the autopsy of Mr. Khalifah H. ATIAH, Detention Facility, Camp Remberance, Baghdad, Iraq, who was brought the emergency room at 21st Combat Army Support Hospital, Camp Cropper, Baghdad, Iraq after complaining of chest pains. It was then determined that Mr. ATIAH suffered from an Acute Miocardial Infarction. On 2 Dec 06, Mr. ITIAH's condition worsened and Mr. ATIAH was pronounced dead at 0951, 2 Dec 06 by Dr. b(6), b(7)(C) Emergency Room Physician.

At about 1000, 6 Dec 06, SAb(6), b(7)(C) attended the autopsy of CIV Khalifah H. ATIAH, (ME # 061137), which was conducted by CDRb(6), b(7)(C) Armed Forces Institute of
Pathology (AFIP), United States Navy (USN), Phone (301) 319-0000. The preliminary cause of death is
acute myocardial infarction and manner of death is natural. Photographs from AFIP exposed digital
photographs of the autopsy and prepared a compact disc (CD) containing images exposed. A copy of
the CD containing all images was obtained. (See Preliminary Autopsy Report (PAR) and CD for
details). Fingerprints were obtained and added to case file.


