INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

THIS IS AN OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM INVESTIGATION.

On 28 May 06, this office was notified by the Base Operations Center (BOC), Camp Bucca, Umm Qasr, Iraq APO AE 09375, that Detainee SALMAN, had collapsed while playing volleyball and had been transported to the TIF hospital where he was subsequently pronounced dead.

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Investigation determined the cause of death for Detainee SALMAN was Occlusive Atherosclerotic/Thrombotic Coronary Artery Disease (Heart Disease) and the manner of death was natural. Toxicology tests for screened drugs of abuse and medications was negative.

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DETAILS

At 2340, 28 May 06, this office was notified of a detainee death by the Base Operations Center (BOC), Camp Bucca. Umm Qasr, Iraq (CBI), APO AE 09375.

AGENT'S COMMENT: Telephone lines were down at the TIF and the hospital could not be reached.

At 0015, 29 May 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) stopped by the ER and verified a detainee had died and the compound number was obtained. SA b(6), b(7)(C) also obtained from the Medical operations center the daily staff journal and dispatch log indicating the medics were notified at approximately 2200, 28 May 06, and departed the area with the Detainee within approximately 8 minutes. (See Daily staff journal and dispatch log for details)

About 0025, 29 May 06, SA (b)(6), (b)(7)(C), (b)(7)(F) interviewed SRA (b(6), b(7)(C) 886 ESFS / C Company / Compound #7, Camp Bucca, Iraq (CBIZ), APO AE 09375, who related at about 2200, 28 May 06, he was notified by SGT b(6), b(7)(C) (6). b(7)(6) 886 ESFS, C Company, Compound #7, CBIZ, APO AE 09375 that a detainee had fallen while playing volley ball and was in need of medical aid. SRA b(6), b(7)(C) related he proceeded to the "Sally Port" of the Compound #7, where two detainees brought Mr. Tha'ir Kaduri SALMAN, Internment Serial Number (ISN) USb(6), b(7)(C) IIF, CBI, outside the compound and placed him on a bench located by the medic shack. He stated that SPC b(6), b(7)(C) (Medic/NFI) checked Mr. SALMAN for vital signs and started CPR, and was assisted by TSGTb(6), b(7)(C)Company / Compound #7, Camp Bucca, Iraq (CBIZ), APO AE 09375. About ten minutes later, SRA b(6), b(7)(C) stated he took over applying chest compressions to Mr. SALMAN from TSGT b(6), b(7)(C) and continued the chest compressions while Mr. SALMAN was transported by ambulance to the TIF hospital, at which point he was relieved by medical personnel. He stated the hospital staff after taking over the life saving measures for Mr. SALMAN, rushed him into the emergency room, where they performed advanced life saving measures, which met with no result and the Mr. SALMAN was pronounced dead by the attending physician.

AGENT'S COMMENT: On 29 May 06, this office obtained the hand written, sworn statement of SRA b(6), b(7)(C) which he had rendered at 2315, 28 May 06, which corroborated and further elaborated upon his aforementioned interview. (See sworn statement for additional details)

About 0030, 29 May 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) interviewed SSGT b(6), b(7)(C) , 886 ESFS / C Company / Compound #7, Camp Bucca, Iraq (CBIZ), APO AE 09375, who related at approximately 2200, 28 May 06, while observing Compound #7 from Charlie Tower, which is situated outside of the compound, adjacent to the volley ball court, he observed several detainees gather on the court to assist a detainee who had collapsed. He related that within four minutes, he observed the detainees pick up the injured detainee and move him to the "Sally Port" at approximately 2204, 28 May 06. SSGT b(6), b(7)(C) stated that from his position in Charlie Tower, he could not observe anything else and had nothing further to add to this investigation.

AGENT'S COMMENT: On 29 May 06, this office obtained the hand written, sworn statement of SSGT b(6), b(7)(C) which he had rendered at 2340, 28 May 06, which corroborated his aforementioned interview. (See sworn statement for additional details)

About 0034, 29 May 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) interviewed SSGT b(6), b(7)(C) 886
ESFS / C Company / Compound #7, Camp Bucca, Iraq (CBIZ), APO AE 09375, who related at about 2200, 29 May 06, he observed several detainees carry Mr. SALMAN to the front of the compound (described as the "Sally Port"). He related that he notified the medics, who happened to be at compound #6 on an unrelated matter. SSGT b(6), b(7)(C) stated he lost sight of the detainee after the medical personnel pulled the detainee from the compound area and stated he had nothing further he could add pertaining to the incident.

At 0035, 29 May 06, LTC (DR) b(6), b(7)(C)
Buttalion, CBI, was interviewed by SA b(6), b(7)(C) and rendered a sworn statement relating Detainee SALMAN arrived at the Theater Internment Facility (TIF), CBI, hospital in full cardiac arrest. He further detailed all life support measures taken by medical staff, and provided a copy of Detainee SALMAN's medical record which included a preliminary certificate of death and hospital report of death. (See sworn statement and medical records for details)

About 0036, 29 May 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) interviewed SSGT b(6), b(7)(C)

886 ESFS / C Company / Compound #7, Camp Bucca, Iraq (CBIZ), APO AE 09375, who related at about 2200, 29 May 06, while loading some detainees onto a bus, he observed SPC b(6), b(7)(C) and TSGT b(6), b(7)(C) performing CPR on Mr. SALMAN. He related he went to retrieve a litter to assist in carrying the detainee and noticed SRA b(6), b(7)(C) had replaced TSGT b(6), b(7)(C) in conducting chest compressions on the detainee. SSGT b(6), b(7)(C) stated he had no additional information concerning this incident.

About 0038, 29 May 06, SA (b(6), b(7)(C) interviewed TSGT (b(6), b(7)(C)) who related at about 2200, 29 May 06, he was notified by SSGT (b(6), b(7)(C)) that a detainee had lost consciousness on the volley ball court in Compound #7. He stated he observed two medics at Compound #6, so he ran across to the compound and informed them of what had occurred. He related that approximately six detainees carried Mr. SALMAN (detainee ISN #5(6), b(7)(C) to the "Sally Port" and he instructed one of the detainees to check for a pulse, while he cleared the front of the compound of excess detainees. The detainee informed him that Mr. SALMAN had a pulse and the medic informed TSGT (b(6), b(7)(C)) he needed the detainee evacuated as soon as possible from the "Sally Port." TSGT (b(6), b(7)(C)) hen instructed two detainees to bring Mr. SALMAN outside the compound. The medic's assessed Mr. SALMAN and determined he did not have a pulse and was not breathing, at which time the medic began giving breaths and TSGT (b(6), b(7)(C)) began chest compressions on the detainee. TSGT (b(6), b(7)(C)) stated he continued giving chest compressions until he was relieved by SRA

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AGENT'S COMMENT: On 29 May 06, this office obtained the hand written, sworn statement of TSGT (See Sworn statement for additional details)

About 0042, 29 May 06, SAb(6), b(7)(C) while assisted by a translator (Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) Interpreter, b(6), b(7)(C) L3-Titan, Camp Bucca, Um Qasar, Iraq, APO AE 09375) interviewed Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) Detainee Chief of Compound #7, ISN #b(6), b(7)(C) Bldg #2-2, Camp Bucca TIF, who related while sitting by the fence of the compound, speaking with a "SGT" he observed several detainees carrying detainee ISN#b(6), b(7)(C) (Mr. SALMAN) to the entrance of the compound. He related the guards responded quickly and rendered aid to the detainee. He stated that prior to the detainee being extracted from the compound, he felt the heart beat of the detainee and noticed he was struggling to breath. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) had nothing further to add concerning this investigation and the interview was terminated.

About 0045, 29 May 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) while assisted by a translator (Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) interviewed Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) Detainee Chief Assistant of Compound #7, ISN #5(6), b(7)(C) Bldg #5-1, Camp Bucca TIF. Mr b(6), b(7)(C) stated while he was observing other detainees play volleyball, detainee ISN #5(6), b(7)(C) Mr. SALMAN) collapsed to the ground. He related that he ordered other detainees to carry the Mr. SALMAN to the "Sally Port" so he could receive medical aid. He stated that he remembered seeing saliva coming from the mouth of Mr. SALMAN. He stated once Mr. SALMAN was extracted from the compound he heard the guards say the detainee was not breathing at which time the medical personnel and the guards began CPR. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated he could not provide any additional information concerning this investigation and the interview was terminated.

About 0048, 29 May 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) while assisted by a translator (Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) interviewed Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) Coach of the volley ball team, ISN #^{D(6), b(7)(C)} Bldg #1-6, Compound #7. Camp Bucca TIF. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated that during the volley ball game, he observed detainee ISN #^{D(6), b(7)(C)} (Mr. SALMAN) fall to the ground. He related that other detainees then picked him up and carried him to the front of the compound. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated that to his knowledge detainee ISN #^{D(6), b(7)(C)} (Mr. SALMAN) was in good health and was not taking any medications. He stated he did not go to the front of the compound and did not have any additional information concerning this investigation and the interview was terminated.

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personnel and the guards working on the Mr. SALMAN and performing CPR for approximately 10 minutes at which time he observed the ambulance take Mr. SALMAN away from the compound. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) tated the detainee had just arrived within the past few days from Bagdad and was new to Bucca. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated he could not provide any additional information concerning this investigation and the interview was terminated.

At 0111, 29 May 06, SPCb(6), b(7)(C) (Medic) 601st Area Support Medical Company, CBI, was interviewed by SA^{b(6), b(7)(C)} and rendered a sworn statement stating he responded from a nearby compound and immediately initiated Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) efforts. SPC^{b(6), b(7)(C)} also related Detainee SALMAN did not exhibit any signs of gurgling, drooling or color changes. He initiated mouth to mouth resuscitation and did not detect any strange smells. (See sworn statement for details)

About 0115, 29 May 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) while assisted by a translator (Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) interviewed Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) ISN #b(6), b(7)(C) Bldg #4-5, Compound #7, Camp Bucca TIF. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) dentified himself as the cousin of Mr. SALMAN. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated he observed his cousin fall to the ground after serving the ball. He said when he approached he observed Mr. SALMAN'S eyes roll upward in his head and noticed he was hardly breathing. He related that several detainees carried Mr. SALMAN to the front of the compound for medical assistance. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated to his knowledge, his cousin was not suffering from any health problems and was not on any medications; however, his cousin had been complaining about being mentally tired. He related Mr. SALMAN was married and had seven children and related his residence was a small farm in the western province of Iraq, near Rawa, Iraq. Mr b(6), b(7)(C) stated he could not provide any additional information concerning this investigation and the interview was terminated.

At 0117, 29 May 06, SGT b(6), b(7)(C) (Medic) 601st Area Support Medical Company, CBI, was interviewed by SAb(6), b(7)(C) and rendered a sworn statement stating he responded from a nearby compound and immediately initiated an evaluation of Detainee SALMAN and assisted SPC in transporting Detainee SALMAN to the emergency room. (See sworn statement for details)

0120, 29 May 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) while assisted by a translator (Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) interviewed Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) ISN b(6), b(7)(C) Bldg #5-1, Compound #7, Camp Bucca TIF. Mr b(6), b(7)(C) stated he was the referee of the volleyball game and was standing next to Mr. SALMAN as he served the ball. He stated immediately after serving the ball, Mr. SALMAN fell to the ground. He related that detainees then picked up Mr. SALMAN and brought him to the "Sally Port" of the compound. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated TSGT and the medics performed CPR on Mr. SALMAN, until he was taken by ambulance to the hospital. Mr. b(6), b(7)(C) stated he could not provide any additional information concerning this investigation and the interview was terminated.

At 0237, 29 May 06, SGT b(6), b(7)(C) and SPC b(6), b(7)(C) both assigned to HHC 785th MP Bn, CBI, attempted to obtain a positive identification on the

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remains of Detainee SALMAN via the use of the Biometrics Automated Toolset (BAT). The attempt failed and a positive ID was made via the use of the BATs photograph.

At 0245, 29 May 06, SA^{b(6), b(7)(C)} collected from the TIF Operations Center, the original statements rendered by the guards involved in the extraction, treatment and transport of Detainee SALMAN. A subsequent review of the statement provided by TSGTb(6), b(7)(C)

At 0230, 29 May 06, SA b(6), b(7)(C) conducted a death scene examination of the rear portion of Compound 7, Theater Internment Facility (TIF), CBI.

Characteristics of the Scene:

Compound 7 was located on the South East corner of the TIF prior to the processing area. The area where Detainee SALMAN died was located in the rear of the compound on the south side of the compound. The compound was between compound 8 and the process area. The area where Detainee SALMAN died was approximately 100 yards east to west and about 50 yards North to South. The volleyball court where the detainee collapsed was on the southwest corner of compound 7. (See photos and sketch for details)

Conditions of the Scene:

The area was dark and mostly empty. Most of the detainees were either sleeping or with some exceptions sitting around various locations within the compound. There were no unusual items, smells or problems noticed.

Environmental Conditions:

The ground was dry and the temperature was approximately 75 degrees Fahrenheit.

Factors Pertinent to Entry and Exit (EE):

The compound is secured with concertina wire around the backside of the compound in the area that surrounds the recreation area. There are posted guards 24/7 with constant vigil over the detainees. All detainees had access to the recreation area and the volleyball court.

Scene Documentation:

SA b(6), b(7)(C) prepared a death scene sketch and attempted to photograph the scene. There was a lack of proper personnel and the amount of resources consumed by attempting to secure over 800 detainees to exam the volleyball court where the detainee collapsed would not have been worth the risk. 

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

The body is that of a well-developed, well-nourished male. The body weighs 174 pounds, is 68" in height and appears compatible with the reported age of 53 years. The body is cold. Rigor is present to an equal degree in all extremities. Lividity is present and fixed on the posterior surface of the body, except in areas exposed to pressure. The scalp hair is Grey (salt/pepper) and has a mustache and unshaven. The irides are brown. The corneae are dull. The conjunctivae are slightly congested. The sclerae are unremarkable. The external auditory canals, external nares and oral cavity are free of foreign material and abnormal secretions. The nasal skeleton is palpably intact. The lips are without evident injury. The teeth are natural and in good condition. Examination of the neck revealed no evidence of injury. The chest is unremarkable. No injury of the ribs or sternum is evident externally. The abdomen is unremarkable. No major surgical scars are noted. The extremities show no evidence of remote or recent trauma. The fingernails are intact. No tattoos are noted. Flat Hyperkeratotic lesions are noted on the knee, bilaterally. A flat raised dark brown Hyperkeratotic lesion is also noted on the dorsum of the left foot. The external genitalia are those of a normal adult circumcised male. The posterior torso is without note.

EVIDENCE OF THERAPY

Endotracheal tube and gastric tube, properly positioned, multiple IV lines into both anticubital fossae, and EKG pads.

EVIDENCE OF INJURY

No evidence of major trauma, recent or remote, is identified. An area of recent hemorrhage is noted on the anterior surface of the distal left forearm. The hemorrhage is of unknown significance and is consistent with possible sport trauma (volley ball).

POSTMORTEM CHANGES

Early changes of decomposition are noted of the upper chest, abdomen and internal organs.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION

BODY CAVITIES:

The body is opened by the usual thoraco-abdominal incision and the chest plate is removed. Extensive adhesions are noted of the right chest cavity between the lung (all lobes) and the chest wall and diaphragm. The etiology of these severe adhesions is unknown. Other body cavities are unremarkable. Small amount of slightly bloody fluid is noted in the left pleural and peritoneal cavities, most probably secondary to postmortem decomposition changes. All internal organs are noted in their normal anatomic position. There is no internal evidence of blunt force or penetrating injury to the thoraco-abdominal region.

HEAD: (CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM)

The scalp is reflected. The calvarium of the skull is removed. The dura mater and falx cerebri are intact. There is no epidural or subdural hemorrhage present. The leptomeninges are thin and delicate. The brain weighs 1420 grams. The cerebral hemispheres are symmetrical. The structures at the base of the brain, including cranial nerves and blood vessels, are intact. Coronal sections through the cerebral hemispheres revealed no lesions. Transverse sections through the brain stem and cerebellum are unremarkable. No significant pathological changes are noted.

NECK:

Examination of the soft tissues of the neck, including strap muscles, and large vessels, reveals no abnormalities. The hyoid bone and larynx are intact. The thyroid gland is diffusely enlarged, 40 grams. Serial sections reveal no significant abnormality.

CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM:

The pericardial surfaces are smooth, glistening and unremarkable; the pericardial sac is free of significant fluid and adhesions. The heart weighs 480 grams and is globular in shape. The aorta and its major branches and the venae cavae and their major tributaries follow the usual distribution and are grossly unremarkable. The heart is fixed in formalin and submitted for further studies. The aorta reveals atherosclerotic streaking. Calcification is noted of the arch and common iliac bifurcation. (Please see the Cardiovascular Consultation Report below).

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM:

The upper airway is clear of debris and foreign material, but reveals presence of frothy fluid; the mucosal surfaces are smooth, yellow-tan and unremarkable. The pleural surfaces are smooth, glistening and unremarkable on the left side, and severely adhesed to the chest wall and diaphragm on the right side. The pulmonary parenchyma is red-purple, exuding excessive amounts of edematous fluid, more pronounced on the right side, and no focal lesions are noted. The pulmonary arteries are normally developed, patent and without thrombus or embolus. The right lung weighs 1050 grams; the left 490 grams.

LIVER & BILIARY SYSTEM:

The hepatic capsule is smooth, glistening and intact, covering dark red-brown, markedly congested parenchyma with no focal lesions noted. The gallbladder contains dark green mucoid bile; the mucosa is velvety and unremarkable. No stones are present. The extrahepatic biliary tree is patent, without evidence of calculi. The liver weighs 1560 grams.

ALIMENTARY TRACT:

The tongue exhibits no evidence of recent injury. The esophagus is lined by gray-white, smooth mucosa. The gastric mucosa is arranged in the usual rugal folds and the lumen contains greenish fluid. The gastric mucosa is congested with no ulceration. The small and large bowels show early decomposition changes, otherwise are unremarkable. The pancreas has a normal pink-tan lobulated appearance and the ducts are clear. The appendix is present and grossly unremarkable.

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GENITOURINARY SYSTEM:

The renal capsules are smooth and thin, semi-transparent and strip with ease from the underlying smooth, red-brown cortical surfaces. The cortices are sharply delineated from the medullary pyramids, which are red-purple to tan and unremarkable. The calyces, pelves and ureters are unremarkable. The urinary bladder contains clear yellow urine; the mucosa is gray-tan and unremarkable. The right kidney weighs 230 grams; the left 210 grams.

RETICULOENDOTHELIAL SYSTEM:

The spleen has a smooth, intact capsule covering red-purple, moderately firm parenchyma; the lymphoid follicles are unremarkable. The regional lymph nodes appear normal. The spleen weighs 210 grams.

ENDOCRINE SYSTEM:

The pituitary and adrenal glands are unremarkable. The thyroid gland is enlarged with no nodularity or focal gross pathologic changes.

MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM:

Muscle development is normal. No bone or joint abnormalities are noted.

ADDITIONAL PROCEDURES

- 1. Documentary photographs are taken by an OAFME photographer.
- Full body radiographs document absence of skeletal injuries or evidence of trauma.
- Specimens retained for toxicological and/or DNA identification are: blood, vitreous fluid, bile, urine, gastric contents and tissue samples from liver, lung, kidney, spleen, brain, psoas muscle and adipose tissue.

Tha'ir Kaduri Salman was 53 year-old Iraqi detainee, who collapsed while playing volleyball at an internment facility, died from "Occlusive Atherosclerotic/Thrombotic Coronary Artery Disease", three vessel disease, occlusive thrombus, healed transmural myocardial infarction with patchy myocardial replacement fibrosis of the lateral left ventricle. There was no evidence of major recent or remote trauma. An area of subcutaneous hemorrhage of the left forearm is consistent with sport-related trauma (playing volleyball). Toxicological studies were negative for ethanol, screened medications and drugs of abuse. Manner of death is "natural".

CARBON MONOXIDE: The carboxyhemoglobin saturation in the blood was less than 1% as determined by spectrophotometry with a limit of quantitation of 1%. Carboxyhemoglobin saturations of 0-3% are expected for non-smokers and 3-10% for smokers. Saturations above 10% are considered elevated and are confirmed by gas chromatography.

CYANIDE: There was no cyanide detected in the blood. The limit of quantitation for cyanide is 0.25 mg/L. Normal blood cyanide concentrations are less than 0.15 mg/L. Lethal concentrations of cyanide are greater than 3 mg/L.

VOLATILES: The BLOOD AND VITREOUS FLUID were examined for the presence of ethanol at a cutoff of 20 mg/dL. No ethanol was detected.

DRUGS: The URINE was screened for acetaminophen, amphetamine, antidepressants, antihistamines, barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cannabinoids, chloroquine, cocaine, dextromethorphan, lidocaine, narcotic analgesics, opiates, phencyclidine, phenothiazines, salicylates, sympathomimetic amines and verapamil by gas chromatography, color test or immunoassay.
