Investigation determined Detainee HUSAYN was attending a release board when he began seize, collapsed to the floor and died. The cause of death was unknown and the manner was determined to be natural.

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: About 1030, 20 Sep 08, CPT [b(6), b(7)(C)] CSH, Theater Internment Facility (TIF), Camp Bucca, reported Detainee HUSAYN deceased.

About 1045, 20 Sep 08, SA [b(6), b(7)(C)] interviewed CPT [b(6), b(7)(C)] who related Detainee HUSAYN was brought into the CSH at approximately 0935, 20 Sep 08, with no signs of life. CPT [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] 304th MP BN, TIF, Camp Bucca, and SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] C BTRY, 3/13th FA, TIF, Camp Bucca, transported Detainee HUSAYN from the MNFRC to the CSH.

About 1050, 20 Sep 08, SA [b(6), b(7)(C)] interviewed SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] who related he and SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] were sent to the MNFRC compound to render aid to a detainee who collapsed in Holding Room/Hearing Room 4. SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated that upon arrival to the scene, Detainee HUSAYN was lying on his back and MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)] MNFRC, was administering CPR while HM3 [b(6), b(7)(C)] Naval Provisional Detainee Battalion Ramadi (NPDB-R), TIF, was assisting. SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated he and SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] immediately checked Detainee HUSAYN for signs of life, which met with negative results. SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)] continued CPR while they assessed Detainee HUSAYN. SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated that after connecting an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), the system attempted to check for a heart beat from Detainee HUSAYN, which met with negative results. The AED requested paddles be applied since there was no heart rhythm. SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated they briefly attempted to get the AED machine to administer a shock, and then made the decision to transport him to the CSH. SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated he, SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] and HM3 [b(6), b(7)(C)] brought Detainee HUSAYN to the CSH, while performing CPR en route. Upon Arrival to the CSH, SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated they exited the vehicle and brought Detainee HUSAYN into the CSH where MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)] CSH, continued life saving measures. SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated Detainee HUSAYN had no signs of physical trauma, and appeared to have collapsed from a stroke or from a medical condition.

About 1100, 20 Sep 08, SA [b(6), b(7)(C)] interviewed SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] who related he arrived on scene and assisted SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] and MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)] with life saving measures. SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated he transported Detainee HUSAYN back to the CSH where MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)] resumed treatment. SPC [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated he did not notice any signs of physical trauma on Detainee HUSAYN.

About 1115, 20 Sep 08, SA [b(6), b(7)(C)] exposed photographs of Detainee HUSAYN's remains. Photographs were exposed utilizing a Kodak M863 Digital Camera.

About 1120, 20 Sep 08, SA [b(6), b(7)(C)] interviewed MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)] who related he attempted to render aid to Detainee HUSAYN upon his arrival to the CSH. MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated he performed CPR, as well as administered Epinephrine injections in an attempt to revive Detainee HUSAYN. MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated a defibrillator was used at the CSH in attempt to restore a heartbeat, which met with negative results. MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)] stated he pronounced Detainee HUSAYN deceased at 0954, 20 Sep 08. MAJ [b(6), b(7)(C)]

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stated there were no signs of physical trauma, and Detainee HUSAYN appeared to have died of a stroke or from Cardiac Arrest; however, would be unable to render a definite answer without an autopsy.

About 1128, 20 Sep 08, SA **b(6), b(7)(C)** interviewed AM1 **b(6), b(7)(C)**, NPDB-R, who provided a statement wherein he detailed his observations and actions during the incident.

About 1130, 20 Sep 08, SA **b(6), b(7)(C)** interviewed MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** who related she was in hearing room 4 when she heard a "thud" in the adjacent holding room. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated she waited until the guard said it was clear in case it was a physical altercation or a struggle from a detainee. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated she entered the holding area and Detainee HUSAYN was lying on his back on the floor. AD2 **b(6), b(7)(C)** and the other detainees were standing over him trying to assess the situation. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated she saw Detainee HUSAYN on the floor shaking, as if he was having a seizure. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** continued to monitor Detainee HUSAYN for about one minute, then Detainee HUSAYN stopped breathing and she could not locate a pulse. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** started CPR and finished approximately four sets of compressions and breaths. MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated no other medical procedures were conducted in the room other than CPR. After the medics arrived, they attempted to use an AED, but it was not working so they transported Detainee HUSAYN to the CSH.

About 1145, 20 Sep 08, SA **b(6), b(7)(C)** conducted a death scene examination of the Holding Area/Hearing Room 4, MNFRC.

About 1215, 20 Sep 08, SA **b(6), b(7)(C)** interviewed AD2 **b(6), b(7)(C)** who provided a statement wherein he detailed his observations and actions during the incident.

About 1230, 20 Sep 08, SA **b(6), b(7)(C)** interviewed SSG **b(6), b(7)(C)** who related he was one of the guards inside the holding room when Detainee HUSAYN collapsed. SSG **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated everything in the room seemed normal and then the detainees that were sitting near Detainee HUSAYN tried to get his and AD2 **b(6), b(7)(C)** attention. SSG **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated AD2 **b(6), b(7)(C)** called for assistance over the radio while heading to Detainee HUSAYN to help place him on the floor. SSG **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated the two detainees nearest to Detainee HUSAYN helped place him on the floor and then they backed away and stood up against the far wall. SSG **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** entered the holding area from the adjacent hearing room and began rendering aid to Detainee HUSAYN. SSG **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated HM3 **b(6), b(7)(C)** then entered the room to help render aid to Detainee HUSAYN by holding his head and helping clear his airway while MAJ **b(6), b(7)(C)** administered CPR. SSG **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated approximately 15 to 20 minutes after Detainee HUSAYN collapsed, the medics arrived to assess Detainee HUSAYN. SSG **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated the medics arrived and assessed Detainee HUSAYN and stated there were no signs of life at that time. SSG **b(6), b(7)(C)** stated the medics were only on scene briefly and they then loaded Detainee HUSAYN into a vehicle and departed the area en route to the CSH.



DEATH SCENE EXAMINATION: About 1145, 20 Sep 08, SA b(6), b(7)(C) conducted a death scene examination of the detainee holding area, Hearing Room 4, Multi National Forces Review Committee (MNFRC), Compound 31A, Theater Internment Facility (TIF), Camp Bucca.

LEGEND:

S=South; N=North; E=East; W=West; B=Base; C=Corner; E/E=Entry and Exit Way

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE SCENE: The holding area inside Hearing Room 4 was approximately 11' X 9' X 10' and was the W section of a large trailer type structure. The floors were brown in color, wood type construction and spanned the entire length of the floor to all four walls and appeared to be level. The walls were brown in color, wood type construction, spanning from the floor to the ceiling. The ceiling was brown in color, wood type construction and spanned to all four walls and appeared to be level. There was an E/E on the S wall in the SWC of the room and an E/E along the E wall about 10" from the SEBC of the room which allowed access to Hearing Room 4 and the remainder of the structure.

CONDITION OF SCENE: The holding area for Hearing Room 4 was generally clean and orderly. There were various items and water bottle boxes piled in the SE corner of the room. There were eight chairs in the room. There was one guard chair on the S wall facing N, roughly centered between the E and W BC of the room. There was one guard chair along the W wall facing E, roughly centered between the N and S BC of the room. There were six chairs aligned in the N half of the room, facing the N wall. The chairs were aligned in two rows running E to W which had 3 chairs in each row. These detainee chairs were evenly spaced N to S and E to W. The floor of the room was dirty and had several visible foot impressions caused from dust and sand. There were posters on the N wall which contained instructions and procedures for detainees while in the hearing room.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS: The outdoor temperature at the time of the examination was approximately 114 degrees Fahrenheit with medium humidity. The temperature inside Hearing Room 4 was approximately 80 degrees Fahrenheit. The skies were clear and it was sunny.

FACTORS PERTINENT TO E/E: There were two E/E's to Hearing Room 4, one at the SWBC of the building and one at the SEBC of the building. Outside the building were various other trailer type structures used for MNFRC release boards. Entry to the overall compound can only be obtained by entering the primary Access Control Point (ACP) at the N end of Compound 31A Camp Bucca.

SCENE DOCUMENTATION: Photographs were exposed using a Kodak M863 Digital Camera and a Death Scene Sketch was drafted to further document the scene.

SEARCH FOR LATENT IMPRESSIONS: No search for latent impressions was conducted inside the holding area. All Service Members and detainees inside the room were accurately recorded.

COLLECTION OF EVIDENCE: A search of the holding area for any items of evidentiary value met with negative results.

SEARCH BEYOND THE SCENE: A search beyond the scene was conducted around the building and outside the door area leading into Hearing Room 4. No items of evidentiary value were found.

NEGATIVE EVIDENCE: The chairs in the room had been placed back in their original positions after Detainee HUSAYN was transported out of the building and the release boards at Hearing Room 4 continued.///LAST ENTRY///





I called control to let them know what ISN was the one who was going to need the medic. I also called saying I was going to need our compemen to help us until medics arrived. Shortly after I first radio to control, one of the board members MAJ b(6), b(7)(C) assisted us. She took detainees vitals and started CPR right away. Right after she started HM3 b(6), b(7)(C) came in the court room and started to assist the MAJOR. They conducted CPR until the medics arrived on scene. Medics then took over and shortly decided to take him to medical.

On September 20th 2008 at 0920, (b)(6) and I were dispatched to a call with a detainee who had a seizure and had stopped breathing. Upon arrival at the MWR court, we were directed to the scene by the guard. Once there, we found a detainee laying supine on the ground with an airforce nurse performing CPR. (b)(6) handed the nurse a pocket mask to use and placed a crapharyngeal airway while I shared his chest for the External Automated External Defibrillator. (b)(6) checked for a pulse and found there was pulseless and extremities were cold. Once I turned on the pad and connected all the pads, the automated External defibrillator started to analyze. I told everyone to not touch the patient and to cease CPR. The automated defibrillator stopped analyzing and stated that the pad needed to be placed. I reconnected the pad which the nurse continued CPR. Once the automated defibrillator started to analyze again; CPR was cease and no one touch the patient. Once again the Automated External defibrillator failed to analyze I told one of the guard to get a litter from our ambulance. The nurse continue CPR until the litter arrived 15 second later. We rolled the patient onto the litter and strapped him down. The guards took the patient and loaded him into the ambulance as I loaded our bags and equipment. Once the patient was loaded, I took the pocket mask from the nurse and resume the position of CPR as (b)(6) took the driver seat and drove back. I continued the CPR as one of the guard maintained airway and reassessed for a pulse. Once we got to the hospital, I continued to do CPR until patient was in the ER then (b)(6) took over CPR. — End of Statement —

RADIOGRAPHS

A complete set of total body postmortem radiographs is obtained and shows evidence of medical therapy. No fractures or foreign materials are seen.

EVIDENCE OF INJURY

The chest has an approximately 5 x 2-inch contusion at the midchest section, slightly right of the anterior midline. The sternum is fractured at the level of the 4th rib. There is a focal hemorrhage of the external muscle tissue of the right 4th intercostal space.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION

BODY CAVITIES:

The body is opened with a standard Y-shaped incision. The abdominal panniculus is 2.5-cm thick at the umbilicus. The muscles of the chest and abdominal walls are normal. The rib cage, sternum, and clavicles are intact. The mediastinum is unremarkable. The visceral and parietal pleural surfaces are smooth and glistening except for several foci of pleural adhesions of the anterior and apical aspects of both lungs. There is no blood or fluid in the pericardial sac or the peritoneal cavity. The right and left pleural cavities contain 20 ml and 10 ml of clear fluid, respectively. The organs occupy their usual anatomic positions within the pleural and peritoneal cavities. There is no evidence of pericarditis or peritonitis. The omentum and retroperitoneum are unremarkable.

HEAD AND CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM:

The cranial cavity is opened with a coronal incision of the scalp and removal of the calvarium. The galeal and subgaleal soft tissues of the scalp are free of injury. The calvarium is intact, as is the dura mater beneath it. There is no evidence of epidural, subdural, or subarachnoid hemorrhage. The brain weighs 1520 gm. The leptomeninges are transparent. The gyral pattern and sulci are unremarkable. The major vessels at the base of the brain have the usual anatomic distribution and no significant atherosclerosis is found. The cranial nerves are symmetrical and intact. No evidence of herniation is present. Coronal sections through the cerebral hemispheres reveal no lesions. The ventricles are of normal size and contain clear cerebrospinal fluid. Transverse sections through the brain stem and cerebellum are unremarkable. There are no skull fractures. The atlanto-occipital joint is stable. The spinal cord is not examined in its entirety.

NECK:

The larynx and trachea are in the midline. There is no hemorrhage in the skin, fat or sternocleidomastoid muscles of the anterior neck. In situ layer-wise dissection of the neck's strap muscles shows no abnormalities. The thyroid cartilage and hyoid bone are intact. The larynx has smooth pink-tan mucosa without focal lesions. No foreign material is present. The tongue is free of bite marks, hemorrhage, or other injuries. The soft tissues of the neck are free of hemorrhage. No fractures or dislocations of the cervical vertebrae are detected.

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CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM:

The 340-gm heart is contained in an intact pericardial sac. The epicardial surface is smooth, with minimal fat investment. There are no epicardial petechiae. The coronary arteries are present in a normal distribution with a right dominant pattern. Multiple cross sections of the vessels show focal soft atheroma in the left anterior descending and left circumflex coronary arteries. The left main coronary artery is patent. The left anterior descending coronary artery is focally (75%) narrowed at approximately 3 cm downstream from the origin and 50% focal narrowing of the lumen within 1 cm distal of the more severe lesion. The circumflex coronary artery shows focal 25% narrowing of its lumen. The right coronary artery is grossly unremarkable. Thrombosis of the coronary arteries is not present. The myocardium is homogenous, dark red-brown, and soft with no gross myocardial fibrosis noted. No defects in the atrial or ventricular septa are present. The valve leaflets are thin and mobile. The circumferences of the cardiac valves are within normal limit for age and heart size. The left ventricle measures 1.4 cm, right ventricle 0.4 cm, and interventricular septum 1.3 cm in thickness. The endocardium is smooth and glistening.

The aorta gives rise to three intact and patent arch vessels. There are soft atheromas of the intima throughout its length. No evidence of aneurysm, coarctation, dissection, or laceration of the aorta is noted. The renal and mesenteric vessels are unremarkable.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM:

The right and left lungs weigh 760 and 700 gm, respectively. The trachea is complete, without malformation, from the larynx to the carina. There is no aspirated gastric material or aspirated blood in the trachea. The lungs and hilar nodes are moderately anthracotic. There are several small blebs of approximately 2 - 3 mm in maximum dimension at the apex of the upper lobe of the right lung. On cut section, there is no aspirated blood apparent. The pulmonary parenchyma is diffusely congested and edematous. There is no consolidation present. The upper lobe of the left lung has a small focus of calcification near the periphery. There is no pulmonary contusion. Pulmonary thromboemboli are not present.

HEPATOBIILIARY SYSTEM:

The 1280-gm liver has a smooth capsule and a sharp anterior border. The parenchyma is reddish-brown and has a lobular architecture. No mass lesions or other abnormalities are seen. The gallbladder is present and contains green-black mucoid bile and no stones. The mucosal surface is green and velvety. The extrahepatic biliary tree is patent.

HEMOLYMPHATIC SYSTEM:

The 80-gm intact spleen has a red, purple capsule. The parenchyma is maroon, with distinct Malpighian corpuscles. Lymph nodes are not prominent in the cervical region, thoracic or peritoneal cavities.

UROGENITAL SYSTEM:

The right and left kidneys weigh 120 and 140 gm, respectively. The renal capsules strip with ease from the underlying smooth cortical surfaces. There is a small 4-mm simple cyst containing clear fluid on the right cortical surface. The cut surfaces are red-tan, with uniformly thick cortices and sharp corticomedullary junctions. The kidneys are congested. The pelves are unremarkable and the ureters are normal in course and caliber. There are no stones or tumors in

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the kidneys, pelves, ureters, or bladder. White bladder mucosa overlies an intact bladder wall. The bladder contains a scant amount of urine. The prostate is normal in size, with lobular, yellow-tan parenchyma. The seminal vesicles are unremarkable. The testes are free of mass lesions, contusions, or other abnormalities.

GASTROINTESTINAL TRACT:

The esophagus is intact and lined by smooth, grey-white mucosa. The stomach contains 200 ml of dark tan-brown congealed food particles. The gastric mucosa shows no focal lesion. The gastric wall is intact. The small and large intestines are unremarkable. The appendix is present.

ENDOCRINE SYSTEM:

The thyroid gland is normal in size and symmetric with dark red-brown parenchyma. No masses are present.

The right and left adrenal glands are symmetric, with bright yellow cortices and grey medullae. No masses or areas of hemorrhage are identified.

PANCREAS:

The pancreas is firm and yellow-tan, with the usual lobular architecture. No mass lesions or other abnormalities are seen.

MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM:

The vertebral column and pelvis are visibly and palpably intact. The musculature is normally developed and of the usual color and consistency.

I do not identify a morphologic substrate for sudden death. The few lymphocytes in the atrial tissue on slide 2 are of no significance.

OPINION

This 35-year-old male died from unknown causes. The terminal event of a sudden collapse suggested a cardiac anomaly as a possible cause of death. The autopsy revealed mild to moderate atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease, however, no definitive anatomical cause of death could be identified. Toxicology analysis of the postmortem sample was negative for volatiles, carbon monoxide, cyanide, and common screened drugs. The focal injuries of the chest were most consistent with cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

Based on available investigation and autopsy finding, the cause and manner of death are classified as undetermined.

CARBON MONOXIDE: The carboxyhemoglobin saturation in the blood was less than 1% as determined by spectrophotometry with a limit of quantitation of 1%. Carboxyhemoglobin saturations of 0-3% are expected for non-smokers and 3-10% for smokers. Saturations above 10% are considered elevated and are confirmed by gas chromatography.

VOLATILES: The **BLOOD AND VITREOUS FLUID** were examined for the presence of ethanol at a cutoff of 20 mg/dL. No ethanol was detected.

CYANIDE: There was no cyanide detected in the blood. The limit of quantitation for cyanide is 0.25 mg/L. Normal blood cyanide concentrations are less than 0.15 mg/L. Lethal concentrations of cyanide are greater than 3 mg/L.

DRUGS: The **BLOOD** was screened for acetaminophen, amphetamine, antidepressants, antihistamines, barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cannabinoids, chloroquine, mefloquine, cocaine, dextromethorphan, lidocaine, narcotic analgesics, opiates, phencyclidine, phenothiazines, salicylates, sympathomimetic amines and verapamil by gas chromatography, color test or immunoassay. The following drugs were detected:

Positive Atropine: Atropine was detected in the blood by gas chromatography and confirmed by gas chromatography/mass spectrometry.
