RESULTS OF INTERVIEW WITH (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

1. On 03Jan07, at approximately 2110, Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) pertaining to his knowledge of the death of V/ABDAL. (b)(6),(b) is assigned to the Regional Detention Facility (RDF), Al Asad, Iraq and was on duty at the time of the incident. Prior to interview, (b)(6),(b) provided a typed statement to RA, Enclosure (A) pertains.
2. (b)(6),(b) related to RA that at about 1730 he overheard (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) say they needed a Doc in box 4 at the HUMINT Exploitation Team (HET) compound. (b)(6),(b) went to box 4 and said he saw (b)(6),(b) medically assessing a detainee and starting Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). (b)(6),(b) reported he remembers the interrogator (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) was standing back watching (b)(6),(b) and the interpreter was outside the box. (b)(6),(b) commented the detainee was motionless and appeared unconscious or unresponsive. He did not have any bumps, bruises, cuts or blood that he noticed. (b)(6),(b) stated he called for (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and then left shortly to ensure the command post was contacting an ambulance. (b)(6),(b) stated he told the captain, "this guy looks like he is having a heart attack".
3. When (b)(6),(b) returned to box 4 he informed RA he saw (b)(6),(b) doing rescue breaths and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) doing compressions on the detainee. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) said he remembers seeing (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) the box upon his return. While they were doing (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) said (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) was removing the detainee's cuffs. (b)(6),(b) stated (b)(6),(b) and (b)(6),(b) assessed the detainee and it appeared that he had a shallow pulse so they attempted to hook up the Automatic External Defibrillator (AED), however they could not get the AED to register because of the detainee's chest hair. When the AED did not register (b)(6),(b) reported to RA that (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) resumed CPR with (b)(6),(b) giving rescue breaths and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) doing the chest compressions. (b)(6),(b) stated the two of them did this for a while and then he took over doing chest compressions for (b)(6),(b)(7)(C). (b)(6),(b) related to RA that he was in the middle of the 3rd cycle of CPR when the fire department showed up.
4. According to (b)(6),(b) the fire chief pulled out a different AED and they attempted to connect it to the detainee with the same results as last time. They could not get it to register. (b)(6),(b) said he and (b)(6),(b) continued doing CPR and could hear the fire chief call for an ambulance. (b)(6),(b) said he heard the fire chief say "15 minutes" and he heard (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and the fire chief say something like he did not have that much time. (b)(6),(b) reported to RA that this is when the fire chief and (b)(6),(b) made the decision to transport the detainee to the hospital without an ambulance.

5. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) said the detainee was strapped down to a board and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) continued doing CPR at that point. The detainee was loaded into a vehicle with (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) driving, (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) as a front passenger and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) in the back escorting (b)(6),(b)(7)(C). (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) believed the vehicle left for the hospital at approximately 1802. Once the vehicle left the RDF (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) stated he and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) began cleaning up the area, but just the trash that they left there.

6. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) provided RA with a sketch of can 4, Enclosure (A) pertains. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) stated there is a logbook at the Sergeant of the Guards (SOG) desk that tracks individual detainee movement throughout the RDF and time of that movement. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) also said that when a detainee is being interrogated there is a video camera in each can that records the interrogation.
