(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) USMC, make the following free and voluntary statement to (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) whom I know to be a Representative or an ~~investigative~~ Criminal Investigative Service. I make this statement of my own free will and without any threats made to me or promises extended. I fully understand that this statement is given concerning my knowledge of ~~the death of detainee~~ Adnan ERD Abbas on 04 JAN 06.

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) for background purpose, I am a (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) male born on (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) at (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) my social security number (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and I am (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) tall and weigh (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) lbs. I have (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) hair and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) eyes. I am currently assigned to 1st Platoon, 2nd Force Recon Company. I have been in the marine since SEP 00 and with my current command since OCT 05 (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) During the early morning of 04 JAN 06, my station was involved in a number of searches in ~~the town of I think it is an Iraqi~~ town whose name I can not recall now. I remember the last house we hit I blew the lock off the courtyard gate and we entered the residence. I went to the roof and searched two rooms finding (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) A 20-30 year old Iraqi male, his wife and infant child. I brought (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) turned the male over to another marine, either (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) or (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and continued to search the roof top (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) about 15 minutes later I heard on the radio (b)(2) As I was leaving the residence I saw (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) escorting an Iraqi detainee who was later identified to me as Adnan ERD Abbas (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) lbs was (b)(7)(E)

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) flex cuffed behind his back via wrists. I helped them get Abbas into an Highback HUMWV and I sat him down in the corner nearest to the front passenger side with his feet pointed to the driver's side. His knees were slightly bent and I am sure his feet were pointed toward the driver's side. I covered his body with a blanket which we got from his house. I covered (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) the blanket in and it was not covering his head. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Then we put the other two prisoners in the HUMWV (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

and covered them with blankets the same time I covered
ABBAS (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Then I got on the passenger bench about midway on
the cargo area along passenger side of vehicle. I was
close to ABBAS which was about 3 feet away.

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) It was very cold so I got inside my sleeping bag
with only my head exposed. We then drove to Korean
village and I did not hear anyone speak and it
was very noisy because of the wind and dark
day. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) I was in the back of the vehicle and got to Korean
village. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

prisoners out of the cargo area but when I checked
at ABBAS (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) he did not move. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) I got closer to the cargo area and got close to
ABBAS and saw he was still covered with the blanket
and leaning (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) against the cab of the

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) I went to pull at ABBAS but he was limp and did
not move so I wrote a O (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) called for

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Requested and looked at ABBAS and laying
out on the cargo area in the cargo bay to the

deck behind the AMMANV and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

fine when loading him into vehicle and I did not hear
OR see him make any sound or movement while we were

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) was the first person to discover the dead MAN (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)
