



Subject: Statement regarding the detention and death of Sadik Saoud

I cannot recall the date or time of this particular event. However, I can recall the synopsis of events surrounding the detention and death of Sadik Saoud. On the day of his death, my first squad led by

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) was on patrol in Northern Barwanah, Iraq. I was in the COC of Patrol Base
Mansion. During his patrol, there was announcement over the Battalion and Company frequencies naming
Sadik Saoud and his vehicle to the "Be on the Lookout" list. Shortly later, I received a call from first squad
claiming that they had identified the BOLO and were taking actions to detain the individual. About five
minutes after that, I received another call from first squad requesting a medical evacuation for the detainee.
When I requested the reason, they stated that they believed the man to be having a heart attack. I pushed
the request up the chain of command, but shortly received another transmission stating that the man was
dead despite medical attempts to revive him. I radioed this information to higher and after first squad
tumed the body over to the family as instructed, they returned to Patrol Base Mansion for debrief.
These accounts are as true as I can remember them given the duration of time between then and now.

1. On 10 Jan 07, (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)Staff Judge Advocate (SJA), Regimental Combat Team 7 (RCT-7) reported that on 08Jan07, V/SAOUD died (at GPS (b)(2) of an apparent heart attack while being detained by Battalion Landing Team (BLT) 2/4 Golf-Company squad, during a foot patrol in the Barwanah, Iraq (BI) region. Inquiries revealed V/SAOUD, who had been cooperating with the Marine Counterintelligence (CI) HUMINT Exploitation Team (HET) in BI, reportedly passed a fictitious documentation he had received from a HET Marine Sgt, while traversing through a Traffic Control Point (TCP) in BI. Following V/SAOUD'S entrance through the TCP and verification of the document by the TCP watch, it was determined the

document was fraudulent in nature, which resulted in a "be on the look out" (BOLO) being put out on the Black Opel vehicle V/SAOUD was operating at the time. Subsequently, during routine patrol in the BI area, BLT 2/4 Golf Company came upon the vehicle listed on the BOLO and stopped and detained V/SAOUD, during which time V/SAOUD died.

2. On 11Jan07, NCISRA Iraq, Cam Al Taqaddum, Iraq, responded to Combat Outpost Bastard (COB), BI, and on 12Jan07 completed interviews of command members at Expedition Observation Post (EOP) Playboy Mansion (PM) BI. V/SAOUD's family members were interviewed and command obtained hand written Arabic statements from family members, a doctor and a witness all of whom claim that the Marines involved assaulted V/SAOUD. The Marines involved in the detention of V/SAOUD were interviewed and provided statements indicating V/SAOUD had a heart attack and Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation was administered. The Marines maintain V/SAOUD initially resisted detention and the Marines had to physically put V/SAOUD on the ground in order to flex The Marines state at no point did they hit or abuse

3. All efforts to obtain permission from V/SAOUD's family and the Iraqi government to exhume V/SAOUD's body have been unsuccessful. Due to BLT 2/4 Golf Company's rotation back to Camp Pendleton, California, investigation is being transferred to NCISFO Marine Corps West Camp Pendleton, CA (MWPE) for the re-interview of the Marines involved in the detention of V/SAOUD. This investigation is pending the re-interviews of the Marines from BLT 2/4 Golf Company.

NARRATIVE

4

- 1. This is a reactive investigation initiated to document the death of V/SAOUD, which occurred on 08Jan07. At this time no criminal statutes apply.
- 2. Subsequent to the submission of Reference (D), Reporting Agent (RA) was notified by (b)(6)(b)(7)(C) USMC, SJA, 1st Battalion 3rd Marines, Haditha, Iraq that he met with V/SAOUD's family and spiritual advisor to request authority for the exhumation of V/SAOUD's body. V/SAOUD's family declined to give permission and was adamant his body not be exhumed due to their religious beliefs, Exhibit (17) pertains.
- On 19May07. RA received notification from Participating Agent (PA) (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)Strategic Counter-Intelligence Directorate, Baghdad, who noted the efforts of obtaining permission for V/SAOUD's exhumation through the Iraqi government have been unsuccessful.

A standard search for weapons was completed with V/SAOUD standing upright (on his feet). V/SAOUD was asked three times if he was Sadik Abdullah SAOUD, and V/SAOUD answered three times that he was Sadik Abdullah SAOUD. Upon determining that V/SAOUD was the man on the BOLO: the squad (b)(2)

members were applying the flex-cuffs, V/SAOUD tried to push himself back up, and he (V/SAOUD) was pushed back down. V/SAOUD was placed in flex cuffs and he was lifted to his knees. He had enough of slack in the flex-cuffs that he (V/SAOUD) was able to reach for his ID from his left front breast pocket. V/SAOUD was talking calmly for about 5 minutes and then he slumped over and collapsed. V/SAOUD was unresponsive and the flex-cuffs were cut off and he was placed on his back. A medical corpsman responded and he and another marine performed emergency CPR for approximately 12-15 minutes, until the corpsman determined V/SAOUD was deceased. V/SAOUD's son came out of the residence and saw the deceased having health problems and he went back in the house and brought out some medication (NFI). Subsequently


