NARRATIVE

1. Reactive investigation initiated to document the death of V/SAOUD on 08Jan06, at the present time no criminal statutes apply.

- 2. On 10Jan07, NCIS Al Asad, Iraq, was notified by $\frac{(b)(6)}{(b)(7)(C)}$ (b)(6), (b)(7)(Executive Officer (XO) of Battalion Landing Team 2/4 (2/4), Combat Outpost Bastard (COB), Barwana, Iraq of the 08Jan07 death of V/SAOUD. Reportedly, V/SAOUD was being detained for questioning by 2/4 G-Company Marines, after V/SAOUD traversed through a traffic control point in the Barwana hop with fraudulent documentation. Information received from (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) revealed that V/SAOUD was in flex-cuffs when he collapsed of an apparent heart attack. Subsequent emergency first aide failed to revive V/SAOUD, and V/SAOUD was pronounced dead by the attending corpsman. Immediately following V/SAOUD'S death, V/SAOUD'S family transported him to a local relative for processing of burial (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) further reported that V/SAOUD was buried on 09Jan07 in Barwana, Iraq, and that V/SAOUD'S family reported V/SAOUD had a "heart problem". Finally, (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) gave no reason for the reporting delay to NCIS.
- 3. On 11Jan07, NCIS Al Taqaddum responded to the remote location of COB and initiated caption investigation. Investigation continues.
