NARRATIVE

1. Reference (A) reflected lead tasking to 23B was pending the receipt of the final autopsy report. The Final Autopsy Examination Report was received identifying V/ABDULLAH's cause of death as "Gunshot wound of the chest" and the manner of death as "Homicide." Toxicology examinations of V/ABDULLAH's blood and urine did not detect any drugs or alcohol. Exhibits (1) and (2) provide amplifying details. Lead tasking is complete.

1. This case was initiated to determine the full circumstances surrounding the death of V/ABDULLAH. No criminal statutes apply at this time.

2. On 08OCT05, Participating Agent (PA) (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) seized (b)(7)(E) and entered them into the NCIS evidence custody system under ECD log number 0316-05. Exhibit (25) details.

3. On 15OCT05, Reporting Agent (RA) obtained a copy of V/ABDULLAH's DD2064 from the inside his remains container. Exhibit (26) pertains.

4. On 17OCT05, (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) USMC, released V/ABDULLAH's remains to (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) CIV. Exhibit (27) details.

5. On 18OCT05, RA examined and effected photographic coverage of the (b)(7)(E) seized by PA (b)(6),(b)(7) RA observed the majority of the suspected blood droplets were located centrally on the under side of the right side of the (b)(7)(E) (b)(7)(E) As background, V/ABDULLAH was shot in his upper right chest with a 9mm pistol and the wound was delivered at contact distance. Exhibit (28) pertains.

6. On 22OCT05, RA received the preliminary autopsy findings pertaining to V/ABDULLAH. PA (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) reported that on 29Sep05, she attended the autopsy of V/ABDULLAH, which was conducted (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) MC, USN, Forensic Pathologist, Assistant Medical Examiner. Examination disclosed a penetrating gunshot wound of the chest with a trajectory that was from right to left, front to back and downward. The projectile traveled through the right upper chest in a downward track through the heart, lung, liver, inferior vena cava, thoracic vertebrae, and severed the spinal cord. The projectile was found imbedded in the back of thoracic vertebra (T10/11). Evidence collected during the postmortem examination included fingernail clippings, copper colored projectile, small white fibers attached to V/ABDULLAH's shirt, black t-shirt, navy blue shorts and a 10-print fingerprint card and palm prints. Seized evidence was entered into the NCIS evidence log #184-05. Photographic coverage was effected. Exhibit (29) details.

7. Investigation is pending receipt of the final results of V/ABDULLAH's autopsy and receipt of the bullet and finger print cards recovered from V/ABDULLAH so that the firearm seized from (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) can undergo testing at USACIL.

1. As background, V/ABDULLAH was reportedly (b)(7)(E) just prior to and possibly at the time he was shot. Witness statements provided that (b)(7)(E)

(b)(7)(E) During the death scene exam, Reporting Agent (RA) did not observe the presence of (b)(7)(E). RA later determined, through interviews, that (b)(7)(E) were the property of (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) USMC. (b)(6),(b)(7) reported that he recovered (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) after the death of V/ABDULLAH, from the floor underneath the cot on which V/ABDULLAH died. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) advised RA he recovered (b)(6) (b)(7)(E) from a pool of blood under the cot on which V/ABDULLAH died and placed them in a box in his room and had not touched them since. RA effected coordination and obtained (b)(7)(E) which were entered into the NCIS evidence custody system under log number 0316-05.

2. On 18OCT05, RA removed (b)(7)(E) from their packaging. RA observed what appeared to be dried blood on the (b)(7)(E) (b)(7)(E) RA noted that the (b)(7)(E) appeared to have been saturated with blood. RA observed multiple tiny droplets of blood on the outside and bottom edge of the (b)(7)(E). RA observed no blood droplets on the inside or top edge of the (b)(7)(E). RA observed a large light-colored blood stain on the top of the (b)(7)(E). Additionally, RA noted the majority of the blood was located centrally on the under side of the right side of the (b)(7)(E). (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) As background, V/ABDULLAH was shot in his upper right chest with a 9mm pistol and the wound was delivered at contact distance.

RESULTS OF AUTOPSY

1. On 29Sep05, Reporting Agent attended the autopsy of V/ABDULLAH at the Charles C. Carson Center for Mortuary Affairs, Dover Air Force Base, Dover, Delaware. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C), MC, USN, Forensic Pathologist, Assistant Medical Examiner, conducted the autopsy. The case number is ME05-0893. The examination disclosed a penetrating gunshot wound of the chest. Trajectory was from right to left, front to back and downward. The projectile traveled through the right upper chest in a downward track through the heart, lung, liver, inferior vena cava, thoracic vertebrae, and severed the spinal cord. The projectile was found imbedded in the back of thoracic vertebra (T10/11). A copy of the Preliminary Autopsy Report is appended as enclosure (A).

2. Evidence collected during the postmortem examination included fingernail clippings, copper colored projectile, small white fibers attached to V/ABDULLAH's shirt, black t-shirt, navy blue shorts and a 10-print fingerprint card and palm prints. Seized evidence was entered into the NCIS evidence log #184-05.

3. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Photographer, Office of the Armed Forces Medical Examiner, photographed the postmortem examination. (b)(6) (b)(6),(b)(7) utilized a Nikon D1H digital camera. The autopsy photographs are attached as enclosure (B).

4. During the autopsy, it was noted that V/ABDULLAH had several non-professional tattoos on his arms. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) MC, USAF translated the writings as follows: left upper arm: "Where is happiness my brother (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)" left forearm: "2225 11 11", a possible date, cannot fully read the tattoo; upper right arm: "2225".
