The projectile was found imbedded in the back of thoracic vertebra (T10/11). A copy of the Preliminary Autopsy Report is appended as enclosure (A).

2. Evidence collected during the postmortem examination included fingernail clippings, copper colored projectile, small white fibers attached to V/ABDULLAH's shirt, black t-shirt, navy blue shorts and a 10-print fingerprint card and palm prints. Seized evidence was entered into the NCIS evidence log #184-05.

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) 3. Photographer, Office of the Armed Forces Medical Examiner, photographed the postmortem examination. (b)(6 (b)(6),(b)(7) utilized a Nikon D1H digital camera. The autopsy photographs are attached as enclosure (B).

4. During the autopsy, it was noted that V/ABDULLAH had several nonprofessional tattoos on his arms. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) MC, USAF translated the writings as follows: left upper arm: "Where is happiness my brother (b)(6).(b)(7)(C) \_\_\_\_ left forearm: "2225 11 11", a possible date, cannot fully read the tattoo; upper right arm: "2225".
