RESULTS OF INTERVIEW WITH (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

1. On 03Jan07, at approximately 2245, Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) regarding his knowledge of V/ABDAL's death during an interview being conducted by (b)(6) within booth four (4) in the HUMINT Exploitation Team (HET) compound located at the Regional Detention Facility (RDF) aboard Al Asad Air Base, Iraq. RA and (b)(6) had a brief interview due to (b)(6)'s operational commitments.

2. (b)(6) reported V/ABDAL was being questioned subsequent to his capture, on 24Dec06 (b)(6) stated V/ABDAL had been in the interview for approximately thirty (30) minutes when he (V/ABDAL) made a gasping noise, wobbled a bit and then slumped forward. (b)(6) indicated he reached out to steady him then ended up picking him up by the handcuff belt and placing V/ABDAL on the floor. (b)(6) had the interpreter (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) get medical assistance. (b)(6) reported at one time in the interview, he noticed V/ABDAL was grinding his teeth a lot but it appeared V/ABDAL was upset with the questioning. (b)(6) advised V/ABDAL never stated he was having any medical problems or any pain during the interview. (b)(6) reported at the beginning of the interview, he asked if V/ABDAL had been treated well and how he was feeling. According to (b)(6) V/ABDAL stated he felt fine. Additionally (b)(6) provided a drawing of the interview booth in which V/ABDAL collapsed in, enclosure (A) pertains.

3. On 04Jan07, RA and Participant (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) obtained a sworn statement from (b)(6) regarding V/ABDAL's death and provided another (more detailed) drawing of the interview booth in which V/ABDAL collapsed in, enclosures (B) and (C) provided amplifying details.

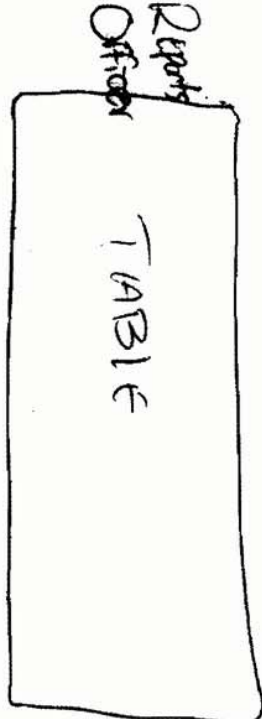

STATEMENT

(b)(6), (b)(7)(C) make the following free and voluntary statement to (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) whom I know to be a Representative of the United States Naval Criminal Investigative Service. I make this statement of my own free will and without any threats made to me or promises extended. I fully understand that this statement is given concerning my knowledge of the death of Khalaf Abid Ahmad (b)

(b) for purposes of identification I can best be described as a (b)(6), (b) male. I have (b)(6) hair and (b)(6), (b) eyes. I am approximately (b) tall and weight approximately (b)(6) pounds. I was born on (b)(6), (b)(7) (b)(6), (b)(7) My social security number is (b)(6), (b)(7) I have been in the USMC for approximately 4 years and 8 months. I am part of HET 10 based at Al Asad, Iraq. I have been in Iraq since November 2006. My parent command is 2nd CI HUMINT Company at Camp Lejeune, NC. (b)

(b) On 03Jan07 (b)(6), the Terp and I were on third interview in booth four at the Regional Detention Facility (RDF) at Al Asad when the detainee I was interrogating had problems breathing (b)

(b) It was around late afternoon and (b) myself and the detainee had been talking for approximately 30 minutes. The detainee was brought to the booth. The detainee had (b)(7)(E) and was handcuffed. The handcuffs were metal and attached to a leather belt that was around his waist. I was sitting with my back to the door. The detainee was sitting on the block with his face to the door and (b)(6), was behind the detainee facing the door (b)

(b) I asked the detainee standard questions like how he was feeling and how was he being treated. He answered fine to both the questions. I was questing him because had been PI'd (positively identified), as an insurgent., and he said he knew nothing about insurgents or why he was detained. (b)

(b)(6) first obtained bio data during which he told me about his brother passing away during Ramadan. I went on to interrogate him about insurgent activity in his village and what he actually did for a living. He stated he was a farmer and a Sheppard. He told me that no one was there to take care of his family because his son's are here as well. He later told me that his brother died from natural causes due to sugar levels and I asked if he was diabetic and he said yes. We had been talking about 30 minutes and I was telling him that he would spend a long time in prison. I noticed he was grinding his teeth and he seemed upset and I asked him why he was upset and he stated he had been detained unfairly. At this time I let him know that due to his lack of cooperation I was terminating the interrogation. (b)

(b)(6), I looked at my computer to save the information and the detainee made a gasping noise. I looked over to him and he looked like he was going to fall over so I grabbed his right shoulder to hold onto him. From there it seemed like he was leaning forward like he was about to fall to the ground. I went to lift him up and he had no response in his legs. I lifted him up, I am not sure where I put my hands on him but one hand was on the front and one was one the back of him. I was trying to get him to stand up. When I noticed that his legs gave no response I laid him on the deck. I laid him on his left side kind of of at an angle against the wall. He was not directly on his back. (b)

(b)(6),(b)(7) When I laid him down I think I checked his pulse and (b)(6) went to get the Doc. I checked his pulse at his neck and his wrist and I put my fingers under his nose to check for breathing. He had a pulse and was breathing on his own. (b)(6)

(b)(6) The Doc (I don't know which one) came in and they took over. I was in the booth and I watched the Doc's check his pulse and then he started CPR. The Doc and I were in the booth with him by ourselves for less than a minute. Doc was doing CPR by himself. I know CPR but I was not doing CPR with (b)(6). There was a guard outside the booth and Doc told the guard, I don't know which guard, to take off the detainees restraints. The restraints were taken off but there was about a 30 second delay because another guard had the keys. I don't know who took off the restraints but I think that the detainee was flat on his back at this time. Around this time a whole bunch of people showed up and I was asked to leave the booth. Some of the people were other Doc (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Capt (who is the CO) (b)(7)(C). Later on the fire department showed up. They tried to revive him and they continued CPR. I saw them because I was standing outside the booth watching them. He was put on a stretcher and put him on a HMMVW. I went back into the booth and grabbed my thumb drive and notes and walked back out of the booth. I went into the office (b)(6)

(b)(6) I had a meeting at 1900 on Camp Ripper so about thirty minutes or so after the detainee had left (b)(6) and I went left the RDF. The LT asked me what happened and I told him that I had been talking to him and he just kind of passed out (b)(6)

(b)(6),(b)(7),(b)(C) I never interviewed the detainee before 03Jan07. I know he was captured on 24Dec06. I never hit or struck the detainee. I never raised my voice to the detainee. And the detainee never told me that he was having any pain or feeling bad (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

This statement, consisting of this page and 1 other page(s) was typed for me by (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) as we discussed its contents. I have read and understand the above statement. I have been given the opportunity to make any changes or corrections I desire to make and have placed my initials over the changes or corrections. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) for purposes of identification I can best be described as (b)(6) male. I am a United States citizen working as a CAT II linguist for Titan. I have been in Al Asad Iraq for approximately 15 months. I was born on (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) My social security number (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) I am working with HET 10 at Al Asad RDF. I am a retired High School teacher (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) around 4:45 PM (b)(6) and I started our third interview. We were in booth number 4. Ahmad was sitting on the block facing the door. (b)(6) was facing the detainee and his back was towards the door. The detainee was at an approximately 45 degree angle from the front door in order to face (b)(6) I was sitting behind him on a folding chair. Ahmad was handcuffed in front and (b)(7)(E) when he came in to the booth. The handcuffs were metal and went through his belt. I think we were there 30-35 minutes. Ahmad fainted and leaned back. I grabbed him from the back to stop him from falling back. Ahmad went forward and (b)(6) grabbed him to stop him. Ahmad started going over to the side. (b)(7)(C) was trying to hold him but he couldn't (b)(6) tried to make him stand by grabbing his belt. I told him (b)(7)(C) to let him lay down on his side. I saw (b)(6) lay him down on his left side. I heard snoring from him while he was on his side. His eyes were closed and his face was blue in color (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

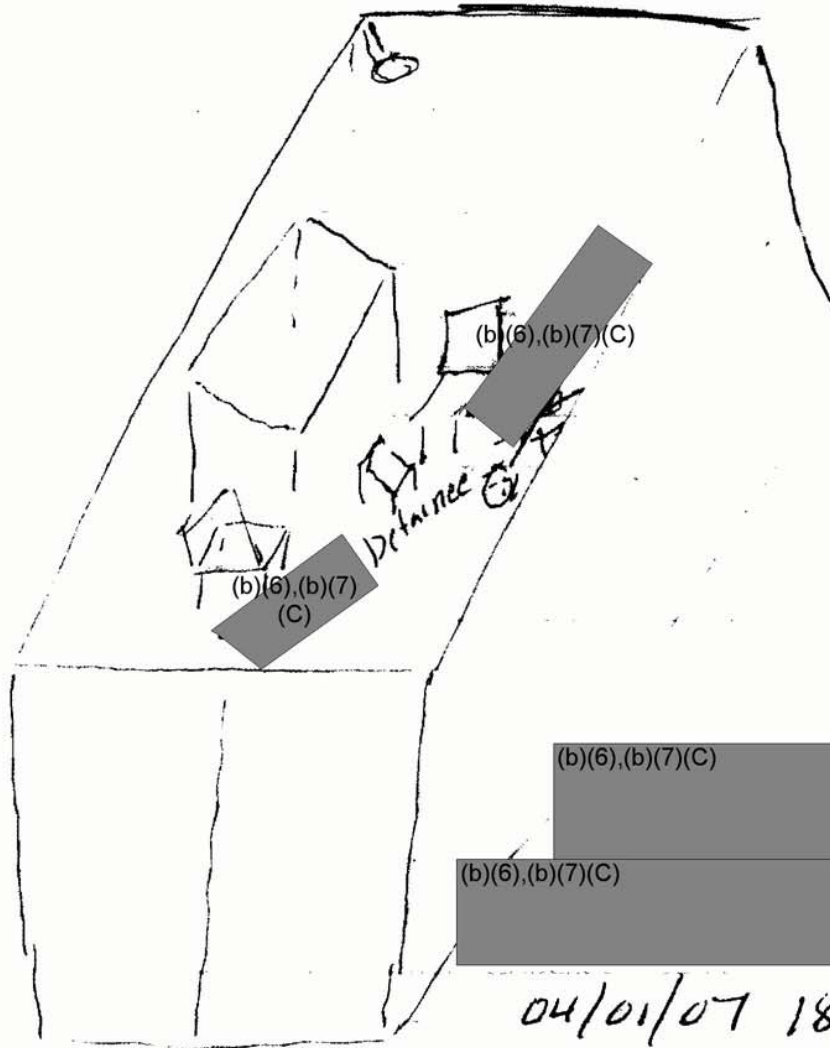

A young man came running out he was on top of him and started giving him smelling salts under his nose. They were counting loud up to fifteen and they were alternating because they were getting tired (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) other marines came running (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

RESULTS OF DEATH SCENE EXAMINATION

1. On 03Jan07, Reporting Agent (RA) and Participant (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) responded to the Regional Detention Facility (RDF) aboard Al Asad Air Base, Iraq, after a detainee, V/ABDAL, collapsed while being interviewed in booth four (4) by (b)(6),(b)(7) USMC, HUMINT Exploitation Team (HET) 10. Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) was started on V/ABDAL at the RDF and continued until he arrived at the hospital where V/ABDAL was pronounced deceased.

DESCRIPTION OF OUTSIDE AREA

2. Booth four, which located in the HET compound aboard the RDF is approximately 120 feet from the door that leads into the entranceway of the RDF location. Both areas are in a completely secured location. The HET compound area has four booths that are wired with video camera equipment that allows interviews to be monitored by personnel on duty at the RDF desk. The video camera recordings do not contain audio. Booth four is a cargo container that has been wired for electrical outlets to allow computer usage, lights, air conditioner units and heaters. Booth four is white in color, has plywood on top of the container with sandbags on top of the plywood. If you stand in front of the box there is a spray-painted number "4" in black paint on the left side of the door.

DESCRIPTION OF INSIDE AREA

3. The inside of booth four contains plywood sheets on the floor; the ceiling and that cover the walls from floor to ceiling. The booth was unlocked in order for RA and Participant (b)(6),(b)(7) to take photographs and conduct a death scene examination. The container measures approximately 20 feet in length and approximately 8 feet 11 inches wide. There is an overhead fluorescent light centered in the middle of the ceiling area. RA noted the lights were on when the door was first opened. There are signs and posters, written in Arabic, on both the left and right side walls. Upon entering the booth a floor heater was located directly to the left and against the wall.

4. A chair was positioned in front of a plastic table and located towards the back of the booth near the left rear corner area. The bottom of the table to the floor measured approximately 2 feet 4 inches. There was a cement block next to the table located near the back end of the table and closer to the back wall of the booth. The cement block measures approximately 1 foot 2 inches high, 1 foot 2 inches long and 7 inches wide. The camera was located in the upper left rear corner of the booth. The bottom of the camera measures approximately 6 feet 6 inches from the floor. Noted in the rear left corner was a folded chair resting against the back wall. In the rear right corner was an open folding chair. And behind and to the side of that chair was another floor heater. Along the right side wall was a

5. Photographs and measurements were taken by RA and Participant (b)(6),(b)(7) on 03Jan07, however due to a hard drive failure on Participant (b)(6),(b)(7) computer all photographs have been lost. Attempts to forensically recover the photographs from the computer hard drive and memory sticks from the Sony Cybershot 7.2 digital camera were unsuccessful. On 07Feb07, Participant (b)(7)(C) obtained photographs of booth four (4) as it appeared on 07Feb07, not as it was originally photographed and sketched on 03Jan07, enclosure (B) pertains.
