RESULTS OF INTERVIEW WITH (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

1. On 26Sep06, an interview was conducted with (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) USMC regarding his knowledge of the death of V/AHMED. (b)(6),(b)(7) was assigned as the (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) of the detainee collection point, Echo Company Forward Operating Base (FOB), 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marines, Haditha, Iraq. The interview was conducted in the VIP room, Echo FOB, Haditha, Iraq.
2. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated that on 24Sep06, (b)(6),(b)(7)(C), who was the Sgt of the Guard, notified him regarding a detainee (V/AHMED) who was being beaten by Iraqi Police (IP). (b)(6),(b)(7) related that (b)(6),(b)(7) did not identify the IP who were beating V/AHMED. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated he did not remember the time, but he and (b)(6),(b)(7) went to the detainee collection center, and (b)(6),(b)(7) observed V/AHMED on the ground, lying on his right side. (b)(6),(b)(7) viewed one IP almost strike V/AHMED with a collapsible baton. (b)(6),(b)(7) told the IPs to stop V/AHMED's interrogation immediately, and told the IPs to take V/AHMED to his detainee cell, which the IPs did.
3. (b)(6),(b)(7) observed V/AHMED had several blood spots on his pant legs, the size of baseballs. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated he called for a Corpsman, and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) arrived to check on the V/AHMED. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated he observed the collapsible baton the IP almost struck V/AHMED with, and noticed it was bent. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated he could not see V/AHMED's face, as V/AHMED's back was turned towards him. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated the two Marines, (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) were relieved, and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7) took the post. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated (b)(6),(b)(7) told him V/AHMED was beaten pretty bad, and V/AHMED was placed in his own detainee cell.
4. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated at some point, approximately 1400, he was notified by (b)(6),(b)(7) that V/AHMED had passed out. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated he went to the detainee collection center with (b)(6),(b)(7)(C). (b)(6),(b)(7) did not participate in the CPR with (b)(6),(b)(7).
5. (b)(6),(b)(7) stated there was no Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for detainees created by Echo Company, as Echo Company had just arrived. (b)(6),(b)(7) revealed the old SOP and started to create a new one, enclosures (A) and (B) pertain.
