NARRATIVE

- 1. This is a reactive investigation, which was initiated to determine the cause of V/MOHAMMED's death. No statues apply at this time.
- On 05Feb07, ((b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Staff Judge Advocate (SJA), Regimental Combat Team 2 (RCT-2), USMC, Camp Ripper, Al Asad, Iraq, advised that Marines from 3rd Battalion 4th Marines, Kilo Company, Battle Post (BP) Tawara, Iraq, reported a detainee (V/MOHAMMED) had died during a Task Force 88 (OCF-I) raid and had been left on the makeshift landing zone for turnover to the local Iraq police. Initial reports from Task Force 88, which were reported between 0530-0600, on 05Feb07, indicated the detainee had a heart attack and expired prior to helicopter extraction (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines, Kilo Company, BP TAWARA, was sent out with Kilo Company patrol to secure V/MOHAMMED's body for the iraqi Police (IP) at approximately 0830, on 05Feb07 (b)(6), (b)(6) stated he performed a quick examination of the body, which was in the supine position, and noted moderate bruising around the neck and heavier (deeper in color) bruising from the clavicle up. Additionally (b)(6)(b)(felt decripitus midline of the right side of the neck and observed that the trachea was abnormal and not centered. (b)(6),(b) advised in his opinion V/MOHAMMED had a broken neck.
- 3. V/MOHAMMED's body was released to the IP's and taken to Husaybah hospital and later released to a person reported to be his son (NFI). V/MOHAMMED's body was taken back to Bayji, Iraq, for burial (NFI). A copy of the Iraqi death certificate was obtained and the doctor, (b)(6),(b)((b)(6),(b)(7)(C) i, noted bruising around the neck and shoulder area as well as bruising around the wrist. The Iraqi death certificate is currently being translated but preliminary results indicate no cause or manner of death was listed on the death certificate although interview of the doctor revealed the cause and manner of death was unknown but no foul play was suspected. Between 07-10Feb07, photographs of the open area where V/MOHAMMED s body was located and the raid houses were obtained. Additionally, interviews of Kilo company marines, Iraq Police and Iraqi locals from the raid houses were completed. This investigation remains open pending interviews of detainees captured during the raid and interviews of Task Force 88 members.
