INTERVIEW OF (b)(6),(b)(7)

On 05JAN06, Reporting Agent interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

USMC, (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

2D Force Recon Company. The interview occurred at Forward Operation Base (FOB) Camp Korean Village and (b)(6),(b)(7)(was interviewed in order to obtain basic information concerning the death of detainee Adnan Eid ABBASS on 04JAN06.

(b)(6),(b)(7) stated during the morning of 04JAN06 his unit was involved in a series of raids at Ar Rutbah, IZ. At about 0220, ABBASS and two other detainees were loaded into a HMWWV and driven to Camp Korean Village. There were 17 other detainees in a 7 ton truck that also made the trip.

After arriving at Camp Korean Village detention center the detainees were allowed to disembark and were escorted into the detention center. ABBASS did not respond to verbal commands and had to be carried out of the HMMMV.

ABBASS out of the HMMWV. (b)(6),(b)(7) was in one of the last validles and saw the Marines carrying his eyes were open and his tongue was hanging out. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) came over and checked for a pulse and was unable to find one.

(b)(6),(b)(7) then left the scene to find the Company's Sergeant Major.

When (b)(6),(b)(7) returned to ABBASS a couple of minutes late (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) had joined (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and they had cut the plastic ties off ABBASS' wrists. (b)(6),(b)(7) spoke to (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) then he left the scene to debrief the rest of the company.

(b)(6),(b)(7) stated his unit has made 60 raids since 18AUG05 and brought in over 300 detainees without any injuries or deaths (b)(6),(b)(7)(did not have any further pertinent information to provide during this interview.
