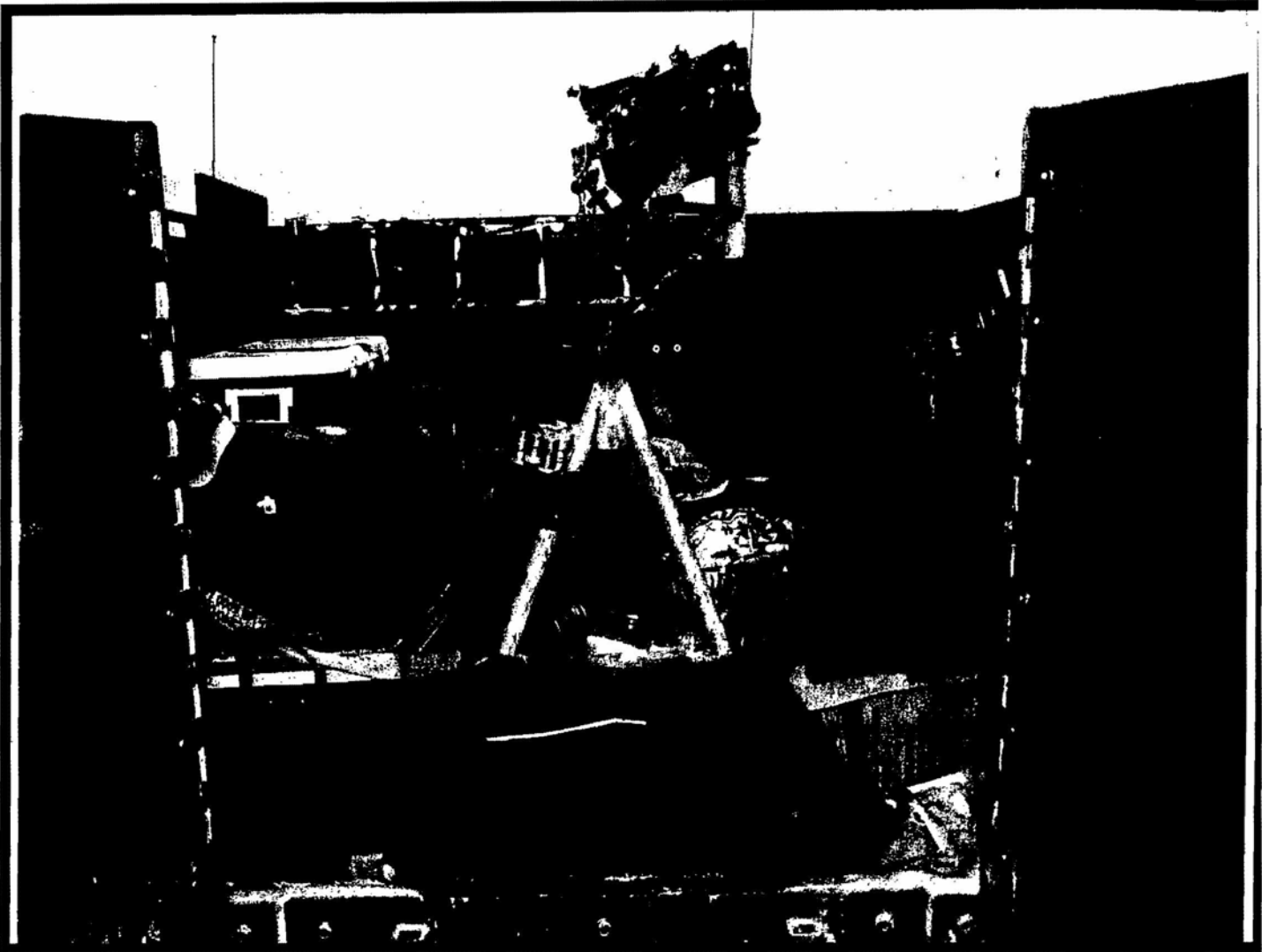


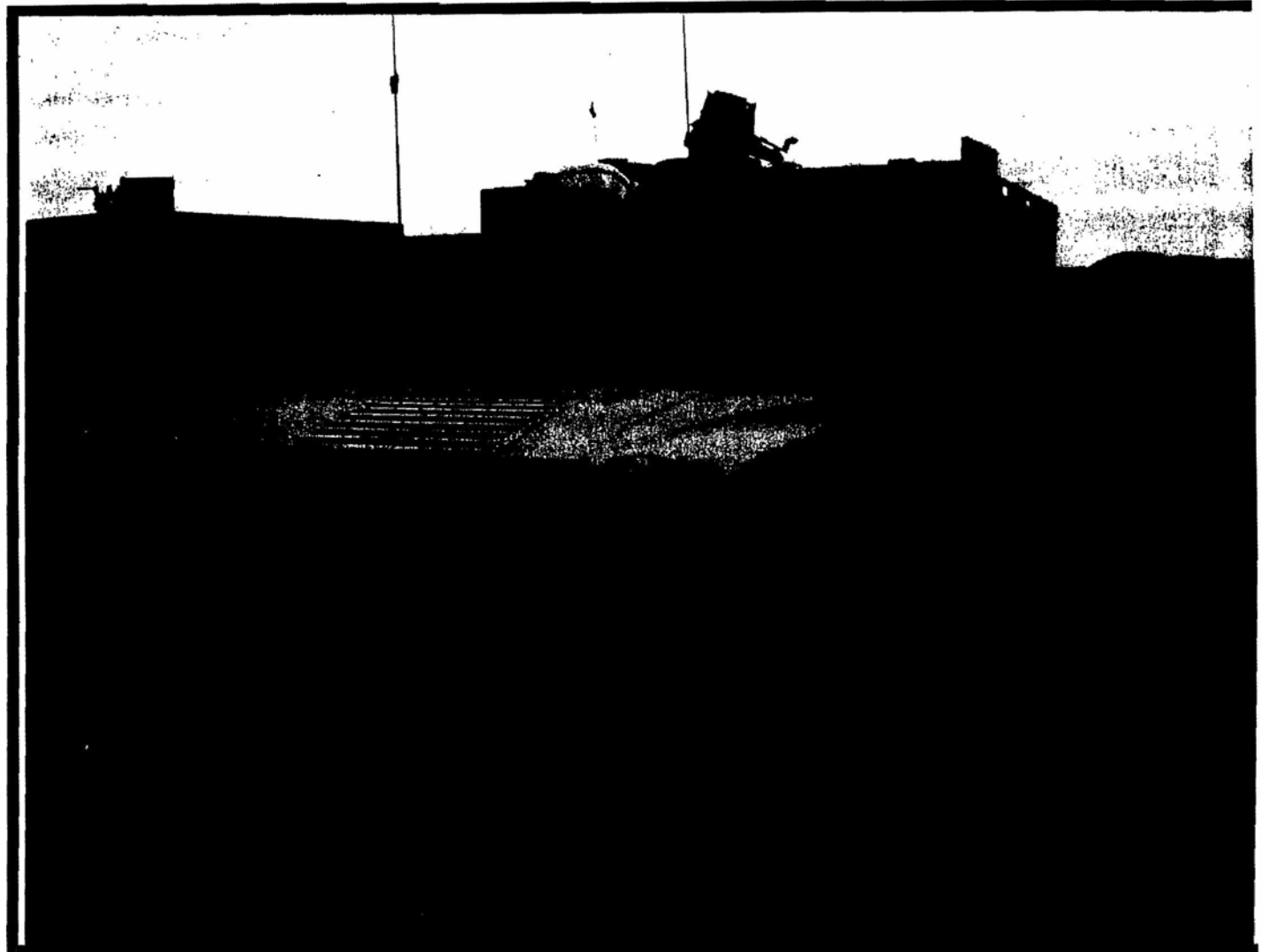

Weather conditions at Camp Korean Village on 04JAN06

The following information was provided by 2d Marine Air Wing (MAW), Al Asad, Air Base IZ on 19JAN06 concerning the weather conditions at Camp Korean Village, IZ. The information was obtained via archives at 2MAW.

During the morning hours of 04JAN06, to include 0300, at Korean Village the weather was broken sky at 20,000 feet (partly cloudy), visibility 7 miles, winds 100 degrees at 02 knots, altimeter at 30.35 inches of mercury. The temperature for the day ranged from .7C (32F) to 13.6C (55F).
