RESULTS OF VIDEO TAPE REVIEW

1. On 04Jan07, Reporting Agent (RA) reviewed the seized videotapes numbered 8 and 37 from the Regional Detention Facility (RDF). The two videotapes, which have no audio, recorded the interview of V/ABDAL, conducted on 03Jan07, with (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) USMC, and interpreter (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) inside interview booth number 4. The tapes had a paper attached to the outside cover which documented the date start, time start, date end and time end for each time the tape was used, enclosure (A) pertains. The following information was observed upon review of the tapes and the approximate times noted below came from the videotape counter during review:

1759 Detainee (V/ABDAL) enters interview booth 4

1803 Interpreter is in front of V/ABDAL and walks towards door

1817 (b)(2) are taken off V/ABDAL and put on the table and he is positioned on the cement block turned towards (b)(6),(b)(7)

1824 Computer utilized

1837 V/ABDAL leaned forward and to the side towards Marine Cpl. (b)(6),(b)(7) picked V/ABDAL up by the belt and back of shirt and moved V/ABDAL to the floor and laid him on his left shoulder. (b)(6),(b)(7) walked toward the door with (b)(6), who left the booth, then (b)(6),(b)(7) looked up at the camera and started waving his hands to get someone's attention

1839 (b)(6),(b)(7) rolls V/ABDAL towards his back against the wall

1840 Block is moved away from V/ABDAL towards his feet area and a corpsman appears in booth, compressions and rescue breaths are started. (b)(6),(b)(7) is located by V/ABDAL's feet and (b)(6),(7) is in the doorway.

1841 Others in the booth and (b)(6),(b)(7) back is blocking camera area, people are attempting to remove V/ABDAL's restrains

1842 (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) enters booth, moves block further out of the way and moves (b)(6),(b)(7) out of the booth

1884 (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) closed the computer and moves it towards middle of the table

1845 CPR continues

1848 CPR rescuers switch out

1853 Approximate time that the second tape (numbered 8) was started and when V/ABDAL was moved on the stretcher

1857 V/ABDAL was moved out of the interview booth

1858 Paperwork was removed from the booth

1900 Four individuals cleaned up the interview booth to include the medical supplies (b)(2) and V/ABDAL's shoes

1903 All individuals left the interview booth
