RESULTS OF INTERVIEW WITH(b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

1. On 03Jan07, reporting agent (RA) responded to the Al Asad Surgical hospital, Al Asad Air Base, Iraq, regarding a detainee (V/ABDAL) from the Regional Detention Facility (RDF) who was brought into the hospital unconscious and unresponsive with Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) in progress. Upon arrival at the hospital, RA was advised V/ABDAL had died. Subsequently, RA interviewe((b)(6),(b)(7)(RDF, Al Asad, Iraq, regarding (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)his knowledge of V/ABDAL's death.

- 2. (b)(6), related the detainee was in Interview room four (4) and he recalled that CPR was in progress when (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) (NFI) came out to the scene (b)(6), reported the detainee was on the deck on his back and unconscious when he arrivec(b)(6).(indicated he stood back and allowed the medical personnel to work on the detainee. (b)(6). (dvised (b)(o),(b)(7)(C) (NFI) went to get the oxygen bottle and they (medical personnel) attempted to apply the pads (of an automatic external defibrillator; AED) to shock him but they could not get the pads to stick. (b)(6), related approximately five (5) - ten (10) minutes into the incident; the fire department arrived in the compound with a backboard. (b)(6), recalled hearing it would take another fifteen (15) minutes for the ambulance to arrive and a decision was made to transport V/ABDAL in a HMWMV. (b)(6) reported V/ABDAL was moved while CPR was in progress by (b)(6),(b)(7)(C
- 3. (b)(7) advised the interview room has a video monitoring system that is recorded to VHS tapes but has no sound. (b)(6),(b)(7)(was reported as monitoring the system and noticed the detainee down and went to see what was going on. According to(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) was exiting the RDF into the compound as the Interpreter was coming out trying to get assistance. (b)(6).(dvised there were two (2) videotapes, which contained the video coverage of the incident, and both tapes had been secured. No further information was obtained at this time.

RECEIPT OF DETAINEE DOCUMENTS AND SEIZURE OF VIDEO TAPES OF INTERVIEW BOOTH

1. On 03Jan07, at approximately 2105, Reporting Agent (RA) obtained the detainee medical history of V/ABDAL, forms 509 of checks conducted, and two (2) video tapes from (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) USMC, (b)(6),(b)(7)(), Regional Detention Facility (RDF), Al Asad, Iraq. The medical history of V/ABDAL showed he suffered from Hypertension, stomach ulcers and prostitis. Records revealed V/ABDAL had been prescribed Cipro (500mg), Captopril (25mg) and Zantac (150mg) and had been receiving these medications twice a day at approximately 0800 and 2000, since V/ABDAL had been processed in at the RDF on 25Dec06, until his death on 03Jan07. Medical history shows V/ABDAL's blood pressure was checked at least once a day during this time period, Enclosure (A) pertains.

2. On 04Jan07, a review of the 509 records of detainee checks conducted from 25Dec06 to 03Jan07, revealed V/ABDAL left his cell for an interrogation box at approximately 1647, on 03Jan07, Enclosure (B) provides amplifying information. RA obtained two (2) video tapes used to record the interrogation of V/ABDAL at the time of his death. Video tapes were submitted into NCIS Al Asad evidence custody under log number 001-07.
