RESULTS OF INTERVIEW OF (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

1. On 08Feb07, Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Kilo Company, 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines, Battle Position (BP), Tarawa, Iraq, regarding his knowledge of the events leading to the discovery of V/MOHAMMED's body on 05Feb07.

2. According to (b)(6), he was on duty at Post 1 from midnight to 0300 on 05Feb07 (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) relieved him as choppers were coming in. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) indicated as he was getting off post he believes he heard explosions and approximately an hour later he recalled hearing additional explosions. (b)(6),(C) indicated at approximately 0600 he went out on patrol and upon return to BP Tarawa they were sent back out to locate a body. (b)(6),(b) reported when they located the body he took a GPS coordinate, (b)(2) directly over the body's location.

3. (b)(6), stated the guy (later identified as V/MOHAMMED) was lying on his back and wearing grey sweatpants pulled down in the back. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) advised V/MOHAMMED appeared pale and had his stomach exposed because his shirt was pulled up. (b)(6),(b) indicated V/MOHAMMED might have had a mustache, salt and pepper colored hair and was between 40 and 50 years old. (b)(6),(b) reported he noticed no gun shot wounds or bruising on V/MOHAMMED when he was getting the GPS coordinates. (b)(6),(C) stated he saw no restraints on V/MOHAMMED's wrist or legs. (b)(6),(b) related he did not look at V/MOHAMMED long. (b)(6),(C) recalled there was "normal" Iraqi traffic in the area but he did not see anyone near the body as they approached. (b)(6),(C) reported the Iraqi Police (IP) arrived and relieved the Marines on scene. (b)(6),(C) related he did not see the IP's move V/MOHAMMED. (b)(6), reported he was the communications guy and later he had heard from someone that V/MOHAMMED expired on scene due to natural causes. No further information was obtained at this time.

RESULTS OF INTERVIEW OF (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

- On 08Feb07, Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Kilo Company, 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines, Battle Position (BP), Tarawa, Iraq regarding his knowledge of the events leading to the discovery of V/MOHAMMED's body on 05Feb07.
- According to (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) on 05Feb07, he went on patrol at approximately 0645 and upon returning approximately two hours later to BP Tarawa, (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) advised them they had to go back out again to locate a dead body (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related they went out of the BP onto the main road for a short distance until they reached a small clearing to the left side of the road (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) described the area as flatland with a broken down wall near by (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) indicated they came upon the body of an old man whom he estimated as approximately 50-60 years old. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) recalled the man was wearing sweat pants which may have been black in color, a white t-shirt that was rolled up on his torso; he was barefoot and lying on his back.
- (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) reported he did not touch the body and after looking at the body he moved to set up a cordon. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) indicated he did observe (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) examining the head and that V/MOHAMMED had bruising (bluish/purple in color) around the neck/clavicle area.
- (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related he heard Doc state V/MOHAMMED had no gun shot wounds and it was possible that V/MOHAMMED had a broken neck. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) indicated he did not see any restraints on V/MOHAMMED's hands or feet. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) reported approximately six to seven feet away from the body there was a can with a rock on top of it. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) reported the Iraqi Police (IP) came a short time later and took control of the body and he recalled an unidentified IP kicked the can over when they were on scene. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related they returned to BP Tarawa shortly after the IP's arrived on scene.
- Additionally, (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) advised he was on post the night before from midnight to 0300. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) recalled helicopters for the raid came into the area at approximately 0300 and that he was already in his rack when he heard explosions. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) provided no further information at this time.

1. On 08Feb07, Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Kilo Company, 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines, Battle Position (BP), Tarawa, Iraq, regarding his knowledge of the events leading to the discovery of V/MOHAMMED's body on 05Feb07.
2. (b)(6),(b)(7) related he was on Post Four at approximately 0300 and recalled hearing explosions approximately thirty to forty minutes later in an area Southeast of his location. (b)(6),(b)(7) indicated the charges and explosions moved in a Northwest direction. According to (b)(6),(b)(7) he observed three (3) guys on the rooftop of one house and observed 'muzzle flash' inside a house that was breached. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) indicated approximately an hour later he believed grenades were used during the units "push out" towards the Landing Zone (LZ). (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) reported he observed the unit "link" up around a two-story house then the group crossed over 'Bronze' (a main street) towards the LZ. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) advised he could not tell if everyone was walking or not. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) provided a drawing depicting the houses and surrounding area as he recalled them, enclosure (A) pertains.

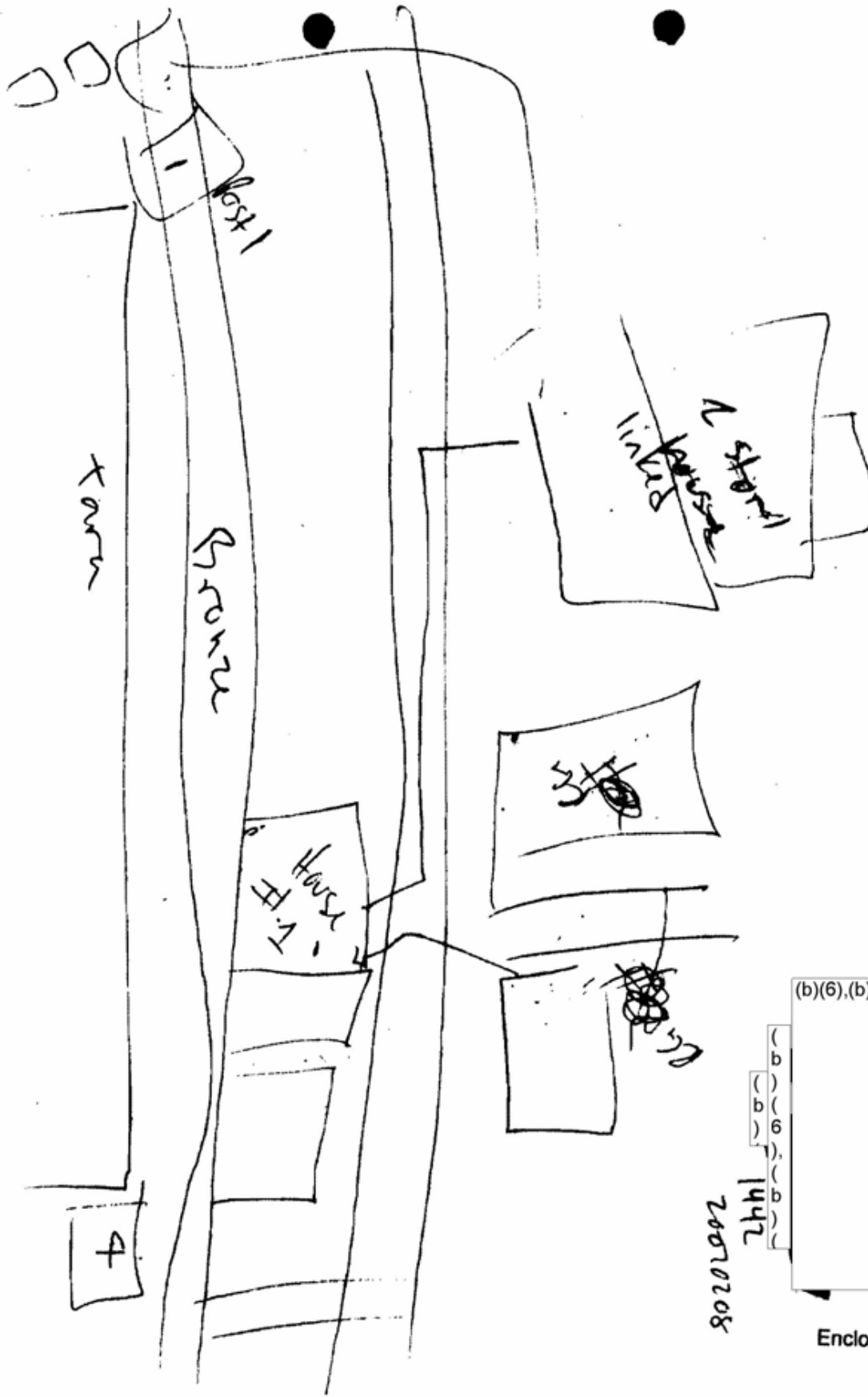

1. On 08Feb07, Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) USMC, Kilo Company, 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines, Battle Position (BP), Tarawa, Iraq, regarding his knowledge of the events leading to the discovery of V/MOHAMMED's body on 05Feb07.

2. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) advised he was on Post One around 0300 and he was aware that a unit (NFI) was out there (outside of BP Tarawa) for a raid. Approximately fifteen minutes later, he heard flash bangs about 50 meters North of Post One. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related there were several burst of shots, then silence, explosions, and more shots and explosions.

(b)(6),(b)(7)(C) reported a little while later he observed the unit doing their extraction. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) indicated he believed everyone was walking to the Landing Zone (LZ) but at one point the unit was quite a distance away therefore he did not have a good visual. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) stated from his location he did not see anyone left behind and he did not see anything thrown from the helicopter. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) indicated he did not hear radio calls and saw two (2) helicopters land and there were two Apaches as escorts. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) provided no further information.

1. On 08Feb07, Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) Kilo Company, 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines, Battle Position (BP), Tarawa, Iraq, regarding his knowledge of the events leading to the discovery of V/MOHAMMED's body on 05Feb07.

2. According to (b)(6),(b)(7) he was on watch from midnight until 0600. (b)(6),(b)(7) advised around midnight he was told there was to be a possible raid in the area and between 0130-0200 there were communications advising a unit was in the area. (b)(6),(b)(7) reported that at approximately 0305, an initial breach of the first building was called in and occurred 200-300 meters North of firm base (BP Tarawa). There were four houses hit and in building (b)(2) there were reportedly seventeen (17) males, seven (7) females and eight (8) children. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) stated the raid concluded around 0500 and the team moved south towards the Landing Zone (LZ), which was West of the firm base.

3. (b)(6),(b)(7) reported (b)(6),(b)(7) and (b)(6),(b)(7) talked to one of the air elements supporting the ground unit and was informed that one person had expired (died) and they were leaving him on site at the LZ. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) had the patrol element that was out stop and check on the site. (b)(6),(b)(7) indicated he heard, from the S2 (NFI), that (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7) found the body. No further information was obtained at this time.

1. On 08Feb07, Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) lo Company, 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines, Battle Position (BP), Tarawa, Iraq regarding his knowledge of the events leading to the discovery of V/MOHAMMED's body on 05Feb07.

(b)(6),
 2. According to (b)(7)(C) he was Corporal of the Guard (COG) and on 05Feb06 he was standing post from midnight to 0600. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) advised he was notified a unit was in the area and at approximately 0300 Post One (1) and Four (4) reported they had eyes on the unit conducting breaches. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) was on duty at Post Four and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) was on duty at Post One. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) reported he went to Post Four to replace a battery and advised he observed a door breach and multiple flash bangs going off from his position. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) indicated he observed two people on the rooftops at a North-by-North west location from Post Four. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related that upon leaving Post Four he heard more explosions but did not see anything. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) recalled hearing one of the post report vehicles had been blown during what was believed to be the units egress. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) reported Kilo Company had communication with Air Support not with the ground unit and that he did not hear the transmission regarding the body being left on the Landing Zone (LZ). (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related he had heard that SOG, (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) might have heard the radio call, around 0500, stating a person had expired and they were leaving him at the LZ.

 3. (b)(7)(C) advised he went to sleep after duty and got up a few hours later, approximately 1230-1300, to conduct a joint patrol with the Iraqi Army (IA) unit. During patrol (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related they intersected with the house the unit had been at earlier in the morning. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) reported approximately forty (40) males and twenty five (25) females sitting outside the residence confronted his patrol. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) recalled the Patrol unit was shown around the houses hit in the raid earlier by a person they later detained. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) described the first house as having windows blown out and four vehicles blown up in the front courtyard. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) advised the person showing them around claimed he was the owner of one of the houses hit and that his father was the owner of another home hit in the raid. (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related upon entering the first house he noticed the living room had nothing in it and that there was the following hand written message on the door inside the main living room (b)(2) 15/ (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

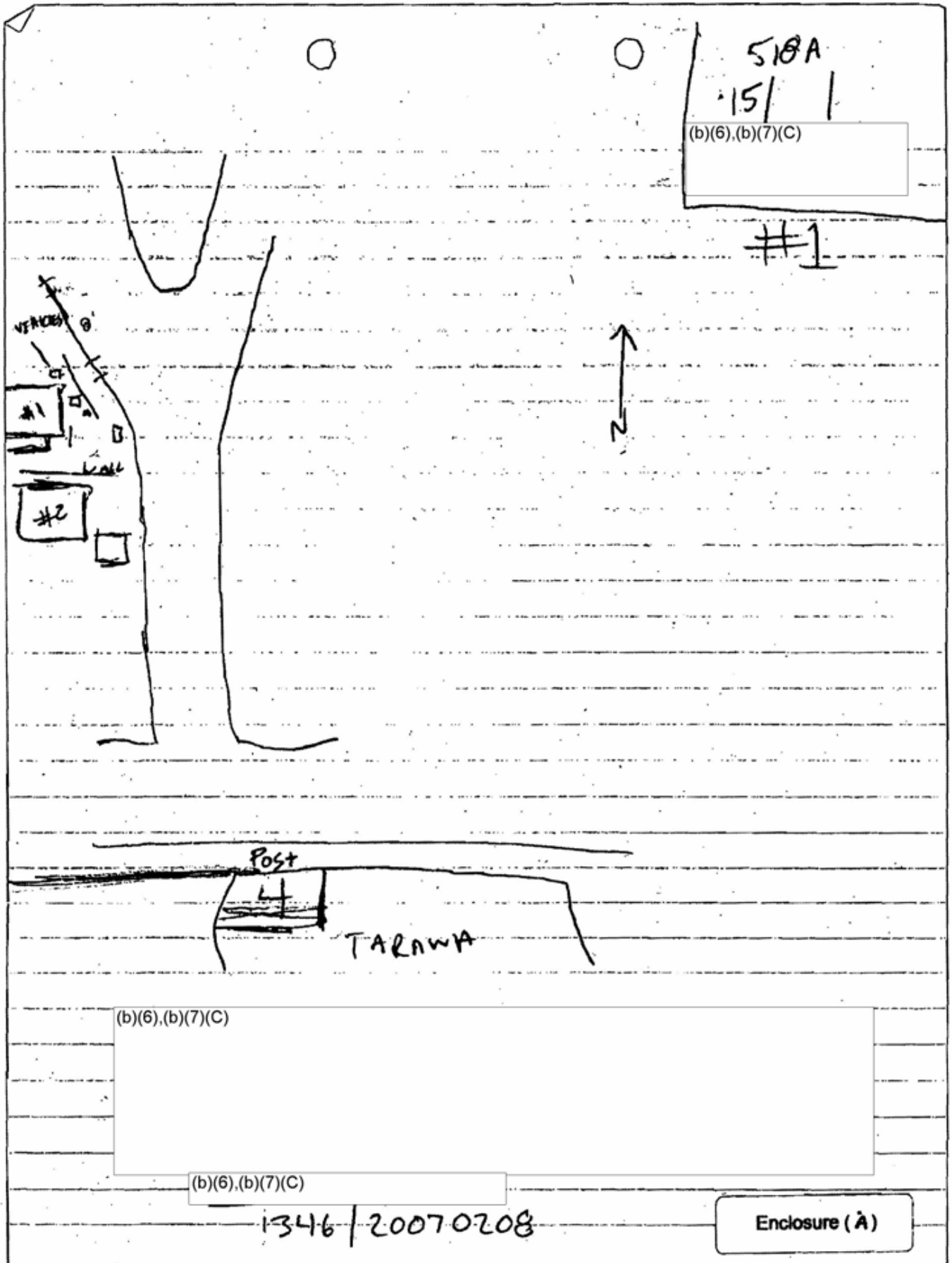

RESULTS OF DEATH SCENE EXAMINATION

1. On 08Feb07, Reporting Agent (RA) and a patrol of Marines convoyed to the death scene location where V/MOHAMMED's body was discovered on 05Feb07. A GPS coordinate of (b)(2) was taken on 05Feb07 over the body of V/MOHAMMED. Several Marines held security positions while photographs were taken by RA utilizing a Sony Cyber Shot digital camera. The scene can be described as an open area, large enough for two helicopters to land, with a roadway and housing area just North. To the East are partial remains of building structures and to the West is the way into town and the market area. It should be noted at the site of where V/MOHAMMED was located someone had drawn in the dirt a partial body outline. Additionally, there was a white oil can located in the open area slightly North West of the location in which V/MOHAMMED was found. Enclosure (A) pertains to photographs depicting the open area.

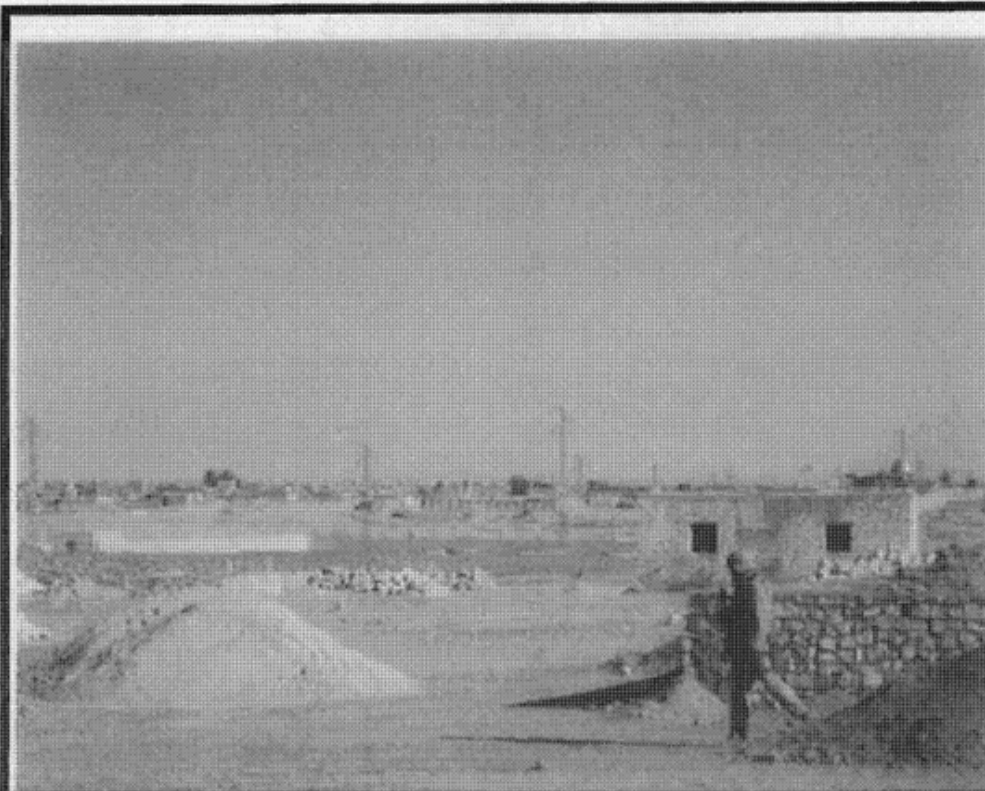

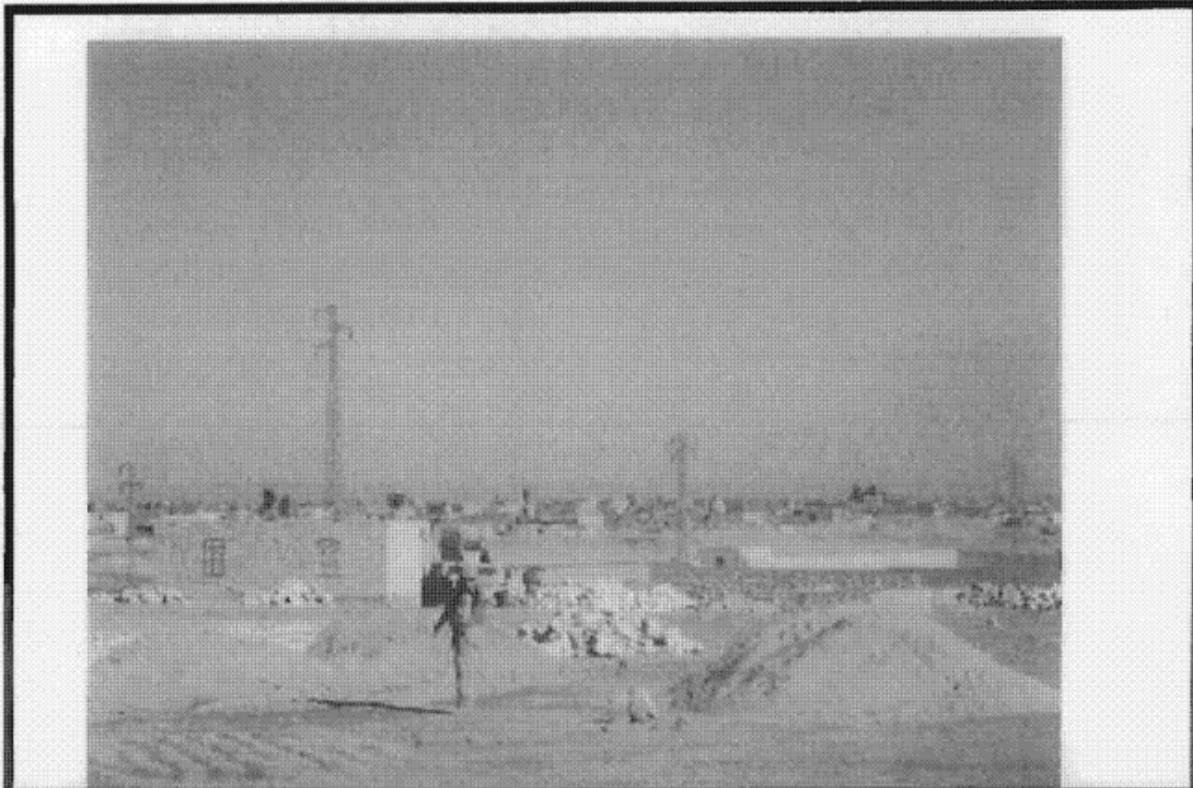

RESULTS OF INTERVIEW OF (b)(6),(b)(7)(C)

1. On 08Feb07, Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b)(6),(b)(7)(C), Kilo Company, 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines, Hue City, Iraq regarding his knowledge of the events leading to the discovery of V/MOHAMMED's body on 05Feb07 and subsequent tasking to obtain hospital records for V/MOHAMMED.

(b)(6),
 2. (b)(7)(C) typed a statement for command, which was subsequently provided to RA on 09Feb07, enclosure (A) pertains (b)(6),(C) advised RA that while he was on patrol, on 06Feb07, from 0900-1100 he was tasked with attempting to locate V/MOHAMMED'S body at Husaybah Hospital and obtain medical records. (b)(6),(C) stated (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) an interpreter named (b)(6),(b)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) went to the hospital with him. Upon arriving at the hospital, they spoke to a staff member (NFI) and asked where the morgue was and if Hasan SALAH's (V/MOHAMMED) body was there (b)(6),(C) advised there were no bodies in the morgue and they asked to speak with the hospital director (NFI). The hospital director related he could not remember anyone who came into the hospital in the last 72 hours with a heart attack. RA asked (b)(6),(C) why he asked about a heart attack patient and he replied he was told (NFI) the person had died of a heart attack.

3. The hospital director had someone obtain the paperwork pertaining to V/MOHAMMED, which was provided to (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) related he was told the paperwork indicated that V/MOHAMMED had been brought in two days prior to 06Feb07 and died of natural causes; however he had bruises on his wrists, neck and shoulders (b)(6),(C) reported they then asked to speak with the surgeon that had examined the body. The surgeon related no further examination was done on the body and there was no cause of death determined. RA asked (b)(6),(C) if they obtained the surgeons name and he indicated "no" (b)(6),(C) provided no further information at this time.
