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



RESULTS OF AUTOPSY

NARRATIVE

1. On 27Feb08, Reporting Agent (RA) observed the autopsy of V/JABAR at the Port Mortuary, Dover Air Force Base, Dover, Delaware. (B)(6)(7C) Medical Corps, U.S. Navy (USN), Deputy Medical Examiner, Office of the Armed Forces Medical Examiner (OAFME), conducted the autopsy. Photographic coverage was provided by (B)(6)(7C) Medical Photographer, OAFME, utilizing a digital camera. The autopsy of V/JABAR was assigned OAFME case #08-0148.

BACKGROUND/IDENTIFICATION

2. On 19Feb08, V/JABAR was transported to the 325th Combat Support Hospital, Camp Al Asad, Iraq, after passing out during an interrogation. V/JABAR received medical treatment at the hospital, but died on 20Feb08, after being admitted into the Intensive Care Unit. V/JABAR had been medically cleared prior to the commencement of the interrogation, and had been under the care of USN medical personnel since being detained.

FINDINGS

- 3. When V/JABAR'S body was removed from the body bag, RA observed various medical treatment equipment was still in place within and upon the body.
- 4. RA observed $^{(B)(6)(7C)}$ conduct the autopsy, which also included a posterior dissection of V/JABAR'S body. The autopsy did not reveal any apparent soft tissue injuries to the body. $^{(B)(6)(7C)}$ was unable to determine a possible cause and manner of death absent toxicology results.
- 5. RA was provided a copy of V/JABAR'S right and left index fingerprints by the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) Fingerprint Specialist, who is assigned to the OAFME. Enclosure (A) pertains. Photographs of the autopsy are appended in Enclosure (B).
- 6. No items of evidence were collected.
