

The following information was extrapolated from the detainee's 344th CSH medical record and his Coalition Forces Apprehension form.

Detainee ^{(b)(7)(E)} Ali Jidek A. SHAKUR; 66yr old male, DOB: 01/01/1939; Died at 080300OCT 05

Detainee was captured by 115th Infantry in Kirkuk, Iraq on 21 SEP 05. During his capture, the detainee sustained a (3) gunshot wounds to the head (specifically the right eye). The detainee was transported to 332nd CSH at 230035SEP05, however he was immediately identified as a detainee. Later, on 27 SEP 05 the patient was determined to be a detainee and was transported to the 344th CSH, Abu Ghraib, for further care. The detainee was never conscious during his time at 344th CSH. On 1 OCT 05, the detainee was further moved to 86th CSH for neurological evaluation. Subsequent to his neurological evaluation, the detainee was returned to the 344th CSH at Abu Ghraib on 2 OCT 05. Later, following his return to 344th CSH, on 2 OCT 05 the detainee began experiencing a fever indicating an infection. On 031945 OCT 05, the detainee was transferred back to 332nd CSH for advanced treatment of his condition, as Dr. ^{(b)(2), (b)(4), (b)(11)} 344th CSH believed the detainee had an abscess within the brain. The death certificate indicates that the detainee died at 080300OCT05, in Balad AB, Iraq, with a cause of death listed as Ventriculitis (4 days) and gun shot wound to the head (14 days) signed MAJ ^{(b)(3); (10 U.S.C. 130)}. The mode of death was also listed as homicide.
