9. [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

I arrived at Abu Ghraib in October 2003 to work as an interrogator. When I first arrived to Abu Ghraib, I received an orientation from personnel with the 205th MI BDE. I believe I received some Geneva Convention training. I received a briefing on Interrogation Rules of Engagement (IROE). I was told what we could and could not do. When I arrived, COL PAPPAS was in charge and I believe [REDACTED] was the Deputy Commander. I saw an MP shoot a detainee with a rubber bullet. The his chain of command took care of it. I have no knowledge of MI personnel telling MPs to "soften up" a detainee or telling them to give them "the treatment." I have seen the dogs and have heard the dogs being used but do not know who used them. Last month there was a soldier who came in to the office and told me he found [REDACTED] thumb drive. The next day I gave the thumb drive to [REDACTED] but she said it wasn't hers. We looked at the drive to find out who it belonged to. When we opened the file, we saw photos of detainees in terrible positions. There were some dead detainees, some naked detainees. There was a photo of a soldiers with live detainees who had their heads covered with a sand bag. [REDACTED] used to socialize a lot with MPs. I noticed that one of the MPs on the photo with a detainee was one of [REDACTED] friend because she had stated his name a previous time. I believe the thumb drive belonged to [REDACTED]. She was in one of the photos. The photo was a regular photo, but I believe there was a file that stated it was her drive. We gave the drive to [REDACTED] and I wrote sworn statements. There was another time when [REDACTED] was disciplined for walking a prisoner naked. She was pulled off interrogations and placed in operations. She used a technique that was not approved. I consider her actions to be abusive.
