9. [REDACTED] WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

I was notified of my rights, waived my rights and made the following statement. I arrived to Abu Ghraib in early November 2001 as an interrogator. When I first arrived I set up my living area, a few days later, I received a briefing on the Interrogation Rules of Engagement (IROE) and I signed the IROE. The were also posted on the wall. I don't recall training on the Geneva Convention but I received training during the interrogation school at Fort Huachuca. I felt I understood the Geneva Convention. My immediate military supervisor was [REDACTED]. My civilian supervisor was [REDACTED]. I was in a Tiger Team and worked with a few analyst, I can't recall their names. Maybe their names were [REDACTED]. I do not remember all the translators I worked with. I worked with [REDACTED]. I used most of the translators. Some makes some females. When I arrived, COL PAPPAS was in charge of the MI unit. [REDACTED] was there but I really don't remember what he did. [REDACTED] was also there. I did interact with the MPs when we needed to move a detainee. I never spoke to them about interrogation procedures it was basically small talk. If we wanted to deviate from the Interrogation Rules of Engagement we had to request it and get the request signed by higher. Interrogations were conducted in the booths, Hard Site, in one of the rooms down stair used for storage and the shower room. These were all in Tier 1A. We also used a room above the MPs office in Tier 1B. Before the mortars I was interrogating in Tier 1A. After the incident with the handgun, I was given the mission by [REDACTED] to interrogate the Iraqi Police. This was conducted in Tier 1B. this is all I did for about a week. I would brief COL PAPPAS, [REDACTED] on my results. I did see the use of dogs during interrogations. [REDACTED] (tall male with a beard, civilian) used them during an interrogations after the incident with the Iraqi Police and the handgun. I know one needed the approval by LTG SANCHEZ before using dogs. I do not know if [REDACTED] had approval. I did use the dogs once or twice but I submitted a request through [REDACTED] who gave it to [REDACTED] then it went to COL PAPPAS and approved by LTG SANCHEZ. The dogs never hurt anyone I was interrogating. I do recall a time when detainees were wearing female underwear. [REDACTED] was interrogating someone who was wearing the panties. There were a lot of people present [REDACTED] MPs, JIDC and ICE personnel. I do not remember their names. I never witnessed or had knowledge of any detainee abuse other than the time I was accused by [REDACTED] Linguist of pushing a linguist off a truck. The case was unfounded they were false allegation [REDACTED] quit when the investigation began. I had no knowledge of any photos being taken or photos with detainees being abuse. I have no knowledge of any video of detainees. I never knew any MI to ask MPs to "soften-up" detainees or give detainees "the treatment." I was then shown some photos in which I identified [REDACTED] MP and [REDACTED] linguist on several photos. The photos were of naked detainees bunched up together. I also identified [REDACTED] in a photo with naked detainees all bunched together. [REDACTED] hung around the Hard Site all the time. I then saw three photos of [REDACTED]. The first photo had a detainee on a chair. I was in front of the detainee and [REDACTED] was on the side. I do not recall this photo being taken. I didn't realize someone had taken this particular photo. I never asked the detainee to sit in the position he was in. I can't recall when the photo might have been taken. I did remember the other two photos being taken. It was sometime after the Iraqi Police incident. I do not know where [REDACTED] is now. I believe she quit after she went to work with 180th IDF. We were just friends and nothing beyond that.
