This was my first assignment for TITAN. Upon my arrival in Abu Ghraib I initially was introduced to CW2 Who had responsibility for the linguists at Abu Ghraib. I was never briefed on use of humiliation techniques or dogs in interrogations. I thought the military interrogators would know what was right and wrong; I was only there to provide translation.
