No person subject to this chapter may compel any incriminate himself or to answer any questions the answer to which may tend to the him. b. No person subject to this chapter may interrogate or request any statement occused or a person suspected of an offense without first informing him of the nature of ation and advising him that he does not have to make any statement regarding the five which he is accused or suspected, and that any statement made by him may be used oce against him in a trial by court-martial. c. No person subject to this chapter may may person to make a statement or produce evidence before any military tribunal if the corevidence is not material to the issue and may tend to degrade him. d. No statement from any person in violation of this article, or through the use of coercion, unlawful or unlawful inducement, may be received in evidence against him in a trial by court-1.2, 1.6)
