About 1011, 13 Jan 04, this office was notified by CPT Battle Captain, 3<sup>rd</sup> Brigade, 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division (4ID), Samarra, Iraq, APO AE 09323, of an alleged drowning of a local national who was detained by 4ID soldiers.

Investigation established probable cause to believe 1LT the platoon leader, committed the offenses of Involuntary Manslaughter and Aggravated Assault when he gave an unlawful order to his subordinates to have Mr. FADHIL and Mr. forced into a river, which resulted in the death of Mr. FADHIL. Further, 1LT committed the offenses of False Official 676-5, bb-5 Statement, Conspiracy and Obstruction of Justice when he provided a statement he knew to be false and further conspired to hinder the investigation by manufacturing a cover up story.

Investigation established probable cause to believe SGT and SPO and SPO and SPO and Mr. FADHIL into the river, which resulted in the death of Mr. FADHIL.

Investigation established probable cause to believe CPT committed the offenses of Conspiracy, Obstruction of Justice and Accessory after the Fact when he conspired to hinder the investigation by going along with the cover up story after having knowledge of the incident.

Investigation established probable cause to believe SFQ the state of the platoon sergeant, committed the offenses of Involuntary Manslaughter and Conspiracy when he supported the unlawful order given to his subordinates by 1LT to have Mr. FADHIL and Mr. forced into a river, which resulted in the death of Mr. FADHIL. Further, SFC to committed the offense of Obstruction of Justice when he failed to report the incident after having knowledge of what occurred.

Investigation established probable cause to believe MA and LTC committed the offenses of Conspiracy, Obstruction of Justice and Accessory after the Fact when they had knowledge of the incident and failed to report the incident to law enforcement.

Investigation established probable cause to believe SGT committed the offense of Aggravated Assault and Conspiracy when he conspired with SGT and forced an 67c-5,66-5 unknown Iraqi male into a body of water in Balad, which was directed by SFC during a 67c-5,66-5 previous incident. Further, SGT committed the offense of False Official Statement when he denied having any knowledge of the incident in Balad, which he knew to be false.






