stated he observed US Marines place bags over Iraqi prisoner's heads and strike bic-lbbthem in the head with pick axe handles, in an effort to obtain information. When he reported the incident to Marine MAJ (NFI) he was informed the Marines were doing job getting guns off the street which were meant to kill US service member. He related he also witnessed US Marines repeatedly pour peroxide and water over the open wounds of an Iraqi prisoner. He further related he witnessed soldiers from the 372nd MP Co, use slingshots against Iraqi children who 612-466 were attempting to steal food from the base.
