

SGT (b)(7)(c)-4, (b)(b)-4 6(6)(5) arrived at the Camp Cedar BDOC at the conclusion of their shift to report to me that CPL Aguilar had an accidental discharge while clearing his weapon at CSC KENWORTH CPL stated to me that after his squad, along with elements from 3rd Platoon, completed processing and transporting out a large number of detainees to a local IP station that he was near the south ROM of CSC KENWORTH and began 6(6)(5) clearing his weapon. He further stated that while clearing it, he mistakenly pulled the trigger and fired one round into the dirt near the side of the road. CPL Aguilar continued to state that he informed his acting Squad Leader, SGT as soon as he saw him to (6)(7)(1)-4, (6)(6)-4 report the incident. Following the shift change, SGT (b)(7)(c)-4, (b)(b)-4 escorted CPL to the BDOC to report the incident to me. I listened to CPL **statement**, and at the time b(s)(s) did not doubt his integrity. Up to that point, I was unaware of any discipline or attitude issues with him. This was the first incident involving CPL methat I could recall. I -5(6)(5) was also impressed with the fact that he reported the incident to me rather than hide it. T decided on the spot to verbally counsel CPL . on the seriousness of the AD and what punishment he could expect if this were to happen again. At that point I considered the matter closed. On 5 July 04, I spoke to SGT pregarding his concerns for his (b)(7)(c) - 4, (b)(v) - 4safety.
