Efficiently Accessible to Analysts/Non-Operatives

There is access to existing (declassified) intelligence records, but in some areas, a more robust use of intelligence records is needed. This includes the need to improve visibility of this material, both within the OIG and more broadly to non-OIG personnel. One final investigative theme must be addressed regarding what material is currently in the possession of the intelligence community, including a descriptive list of the material, and the intelligence community to make them through the process of getting material released to criminal investigators. If criminal investigators are asked to explicitly ask for specific items, it will be impossible to make progress. They simply do not know what to ask for. Rather, intelligence community must affirmatively produce the material in their possession. Priority to be placed on material that has been translated during intelligence exploitation process as it will not burden limited linguist/translation assets.
