- 1. This is in fact a followup. Mr. was found at Bucca, and the MPs there conducting followup interview with him. This is the same investigatory chain that was initiated back in May. The fact that CID just got this info is a result of time-lag tracking the detainee down and getting him interviewed.
- 2. The change in status to "SSI reportable" reflects a bureaucratic change, and not a substantive one. When they relooked the case, it met their internal criteria, based on type of allegation alone, to be reportable.
