On 15 Dec 03, [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 ISN# [REDACTED] b(7)(C)5, was interviewed at Camp Delta, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba by SA [REDACTED] (AFOSI). [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-1 provided Urdu/English language translation. b(7)(C)-2 b(7)(C)-1

The interview was conducted in response to HQ CITF lead request dated 8 Dec 03.

After discussing the purpose of the interview [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 provided the following information:

[REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 advised he has never been to the U.S. He has only been to Pakistan and Afghanistan. [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 said that during the timeframe of 15 Aug 01-17 Oct 01 he was either in Pakistan or Afghanistan but he definitely was not in the U.S.

[REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 re-stated the same information obtained from the 3 Sep 03 interview. He knew [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 as [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 and met him in MES. He advised that he did not speak with him very much or at great lengths. He never discussed the Jihad, fighting, or training camps he has been to. [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 never told [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 he was a member of the Taliban. [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 has not seen [REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 since this time at MES.

[REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 advised that he completed his diploma after 4 1/2 years of training. He also received a diploma in acupuncture, which he received during the same timeframe from the National Acupuncture College.

[REDACTED] b(7)(C)-5 stated that he was able to open his own clinic with the help of his family. The clinic was small and any help he received from his family (money or supplies) was sufficient to bring the clinic to operational status. He said that his

clinic also received free medical supplies (medicine and equipment) from local companies.

^{b(7)(C)-5} currently refuses medical attention because he did not receive adequate medical attention in the past. He stated that he complained of headaches and neck pain and was told that an appointment was being made but no doctor came to check the problem. ^{b(7)(C)-5} requested a specific medicine for a rash, which he had, but was told by a nurse that the medicine could not be administered. ^{b(7)(C)-5} advised that this negative treatment is the cause for his current refusal for medical treatment.

^{b(7)(C)-5} He stated that if he was given good treatment then he would accept it but if he were forced to accept medical treatment then he would blatantly refuse.

Answer: ^{b(7)(C)-5} ^{b(7)(C)-3} advised that ^{b(7)(C)-5} was not involved with Al-Qaida or any terrorist organization. He has never heard information that ^{b(7)(C)-5} was planning or assisting in attacks against U.S. forces.

^{b(7)(C)-5} ^{b(7)(C)-3} advised that ^{b(7)(C)-3} was involved with the deaths of local people due to tribal conflicts. He never seen him kill anyone but heard rumors that he was responsible for the deaths of people in his area.

^{b(7)(C)-5} ^{b(7)(C)-3} stated that ^{b(7)(C)-3} was not involved in any other illegal activity but is in the real estate business (buying and selling homes) and is very busy running his business.

^{b(7)(C)-5} ^{b(7)(C)-3} ^{b(7)(C)-5} advised that if he was released that he would not go back to Afghanistan even though his wife is there. His wife requested a divorce because of ^{b(7)(C)-3} and ^{b(7)(C)-3} does not want to go back. He previously stated that he wanted to kill ^{b(7)(C)-3} but recanted, stating that he said a lot of things when he was angry. He no longer wishes to kill ^{b(7)(C)-3} and he no longer wishes to go back to Afghanistan. He does not know where he would go if he were released. ^{b(7)(C)-3}
