[REDACTED] was interviewed by Special Agent (SA) [REDACTED] - b(7)(C)-1
and SA [REDACTED], Air Force Office of Special Investigations, at Camp Delta, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. The
interview was conducted in the Arabic language and translated by linguist [REDACTED] - b(7)(C)-2. The following information,
regarding conflicts in his case file, was provided by [REDACTED] - b(7)(C)-2

[REDACTED] - b(7)(C)-5 [REDACTED] - b(7)(C)-1 [REDACTED] - b(7)(C)-2
[REDACTED] stated that he had traveled to Afghanistan to learn and memorize the Koran, not to teach it. He did spend
two years at the Institute for Arabic Studies, but denies ever seeing USAMA BIN LADEN at the institute, as previously
reported. [REDACTED] related that he had previously told this to interrogators in Afghanistan because he had beaten.
[REDACTED] related that he did not know of any affiliations between anyone at the Institute and Al-Queda. When asked
about specific persons, with whom he had previously admitted to knowing, [REDACTED] stated that since his capture he
has lost his memory. [REDACTED] refused to provide any further details.
