Subject Interview of: (UNK) [REDACTED] - b7(C)-5

Date/Place: 13 Apr 04/GTMO, Cuba

[REDACTED] interviewed by SA [REDACTED] AFOSI, at Camp Delta, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. The interview was conducted in the Arabic language and translated by linguist [REDACTED] - b7(C)-2

[REDACTED] was uncooperative and refused to answer questions. He said he would keep his answer to himself when asked if he felt fighting in the Jihad was worth it or if he would fight in another Jihad. [REDACTED] was told his cooperation was necessary to move his case forward and he still refused to answer questions. He eventually said he would not talk because the detainees in Romeo block did not have long pants. [REDACTED] felt this was an attack on Islam by the United States and it was a violation of their human rights. He asked what government has the right to attack a religion. Several attempts to gain [REDACTED] cooperation were unsuccessful and the interview was terminated.
