**1. (U) Significant Activities**  
**RFIs**

The following information was provided to DoD concerning interactions with the ICRC:

- ICRC does not receive reports on person detained during OEF other than letters of transfer when detainees are transferred to or released from GTMO.
- All correspondence with the ICRC concerning OEF have been reviewed and approved by ASD SO/LIC.
- NDRC provides weekly reports to the ICRC on person detained during OIF.
- NDRC replies to all requests for information concerning the reports provided after vetting those responses through ASD SO/LIC.
- The ICRC has not provided NDRC of PMG with any reports on findings in the individual internment facilities. These reports are provided to the commanders in Theater.

**2. (U) Current Operations**  
**Seven Day Focus (Close Battle)**

- NDRC has two inquiries concerning perceived report discrepancies. These are being researched by the NDRC and CJTF 7 and the responses will be provided to ASD SO/LIC for review prior to replying to ICRC.

**3. (U) Future Operations**  
**Long Range Focus (Deep Battle)**

- Review I/R policy upon completion of the IG report
- Working with the G3 to infuse 31E Correction Specialist into future rotations
- Activating an I/R Battalion and I/R Companies in FY 05/06
- Recommended Army assign 31Es to FS for UEx and UEy HQs staff to conduct compliance inspections
- PMG is currently negotiating with EDS to add a full range of biometrics to the Detainee Reporting System (DRS) by mid-August 2004
