I have been reviewing this ROI and attached court documents, concerning a class action suit against all kinds of people and organizations and feel this case may need your attention.

The detainees name was identified as later id'd as to a Time Magazine article claimed he was taken form his home on the outskirts of bagndad, iz, last November 2003, and sent to Abu. While there he was forced to disrobe and attached electrical wires to his genitals and shocked, which ruptured veins on his penis and refused medical attention. He also alleged he was held down by other guards and forced to have sex with a female soldier, while blindfolded with a bag. Other parts of the file state he was forced to strip naked, and a dog leash was put around his neck and he was forced to be on his hands knees with other detainees.

I have the detainee file from BCCF, which has limited information. The one thing that stands out from the rest of the cases here on the TF is that he claims he was abused by guards BCCF and BUCCA, not taken by unidentified individuals and interrogated, which has been the norm in our cases.

We took a look at your spreadsheet and didn't find any information for this individual, and he is not identified in the report from CID Command at the behest of MG RYDER, but he is identified in the Class Action suit.

The detainee was moved to BUCCA and has since been released. He was never interviewed by CID and I have been unable to find any additional records for him, other than the minimal paperwork included in his detainee record from BCCF.

I have come to the end of my leads and just wanted to check with you to determine if you had any interest in this one, before I suggest to Mr.




