About 1000, 04 Aug 04, SA and Interpreter Titan Corporation, Baghdad International Airport (BIAP), Baghdad, Iraq, interviewed Detainee at the BCCF In-Processing facility. Detainee stated he was captured on either 06 or 07 Jul 04 while at an acquaintance's home trying to collect \$200 the acquaintance the owed him. Detainee said the acquaintance's home is located outside of the town of Fallujah, Iraq. Detainee stated that US forces burst into the home and made everyone at the location lie on the floor. The soldiers handcuffed all of the males and placed blindfolds over their eyes. The soldiers then led them outside and placed them inside a vehicle. Detainee said the soldiers virtually threw them into the vehicles and then walked on top of them once they were inside the vehicle. Detained could not describe the type of vehicle he was placed into. They detainees were all taken to another location and placed inside buildings. Detainee stated he believed he remained at this facility for approximately ten days. He was not sure where the facility was located, but he heard other detainees talking about being in the area of BIAP. He also heard aircraft noise close by while at this location. During his time there. Detainee stated he was interrogated numerous times. Detainee stated during his interrogation, the translator would punch and kick him. Detained stated that on one occasion the interpreter kicked him in the butt so hard that he started to bleed out the rectum. He said he was taken the doctor and the doctor gave him some pills to stop the bleeding. He claimed that on several occasion while trying to walk with leg iron on, the translator would step on the chain

connecting the two bracelets and knock him over. The translator would then direct the guards, who he describes as US soldiers, no further description, to drag him to where ever they were going. He also claimed the interpreter placed his shoe in his mouth and struck the back of his head. Detained also claims he was forced to clean the toilets with his bare hands and was denied the opportunity to wash his hands after accomplishing this assignment. According to Detained the translator told him that he was mistranslating his responses because he (the translator) was a Shiite and he (the detainee) was Sunni.

Detainee described the interpreter as a male mid-eastern, approximately 35 years of age, 6'0", 180, medium build, black hair, dark eyes, with a full black beard and moustache. Further, he said the interpreter always worn civilian clothes with standard, DCU combat boots. Detainee stated the interpreter spoke Arabic with an Iraqi accent. He said he believed he could identify him if seen again.

Detained stated he had not been abused since arriving at BCCF. He did not complain of any long-term medical problems.

Agent's Comment: No photographs of Detainee were taken since there was no visible evidence of abuse or injuries.

About 1000, 04 Aug 04, SA coordinated with SPC Magistrates Cell Legal Specialist, BCCF, AGI, who stated the detainee file for was transferred to MNC-I Detainee Operations, Camp Victory, Iraq.
