d. Interrogation Techniques/Treatment of Detainees. I received that implements CITF-7 (now MNF-VMNC-I) detention policy and procedures for processing and handling detainees and for CJSOTF-AP temporary holding facilities (THFs). LT informed me that he knew of no guidance from CJTF-7 8(0 (now MNF-VMNC-I) on policies or procedures for handling detainees or restrictions on interrogation prior to the 48hr report requirement per received the CJSOTF-AP Detainee Interrogation Worksheet (attached hereto). The worksheet is completed prior to interrogation. It is used to determine if there is doubt concerning the detainee's status. It is also used to determine authorized interrogation techniques IAW COMCJTF-7 Policy Letter, dated 14 SEP 2003. I also received sample of completed interrogation Worksheets.

e. Training for Soldiers Guarding Detainees. Implements to formal certification process for their soldiers who guard detainees. However, there is a Guard SOP that must be read by each soldier prior to the start of their guard shift and they must sign noting that they understand the rules and procedures and will follow them. I received copies of the guard's logs that they are required to keep during their shifts. I also received copies of the current detainees' logs that are posted on the cell door for each detainee and note significant actions such as when they detained is given a bathroom break or fed.
