I WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH.

I, [REDACTED], swear that the summary of [REDACTED] oral statement given to [REDACTED] on 23 May 2004, is accurate and complete. It is not verbatim, but does contain the substance of all statements made by [REDACTED].

I served in the Iraqi Army for 17 years as a technician for generators and coolants. I also worked with KBR delivering generators to a restaurant at BIAF, in January. I worked as a subcontractor for a Kuwaiti company which was a subcontractor of KBR with [REDACTED]. I was detained at my home at two a.m. while I was sleeping. They left my wife and children in the house, and they were treated appropriately. They handcuffed my hands behind my back and put a bag over my head. They searched my house for explosives. I've never touched any explosives. I don't know if they found anything. They took me from my house to a building, down some stairs and into a room, and tied me to some metal shelves and then they locked the door. It was like a basement, so I couldn't tell if it was night or day. They let me take the blindfold off in the room. There was a light in the room and no windows. They took me back to a room with cuffs on the floor. In that room there was a space for generators. The interrogation room was white, and there were three chairs in front of me, it was like a shower room. I had a bag over my head and I was handcuffed in the front. I was there for 17 days and then they took me to Taji. In Taji I asked what the date was and they told me it was Tuesday the 20th of April. I slept on the floor with no mat and no bed. I was wearing the clothes I was wearing when I got detained. They didn't let me shower. I was fed only bread and water. It was a long period of time between getting bread. I never got a blanket. I used the pillowcase to sleep on. There were two guys there when I first got there, one was [REDACTED]. They were transferred and two other guys came, one named [REDACTED] was here, then he went to Abu Ghraib. [REDACTED] and I split up at Taji. I knew I was at [REDACTED] because the other guys that were in there with me told me. During the interrogation when they asked me if I knew someone and I said I didn't, he would beat me. After that I told him whatever you want to write down, fine. There were two Iraqi interrogators one was named [REDACTED] and he never spoke English, just Arabic. He was short and chubby and I was told he used to be a Staff Sergeant in the Iraqi Army. [REDACTED] spoke English and Arabic. Only [REDACTED] treated me rough. [REDACTED] used to bring the dog, named [REDACTED] so scare me and scratch me. [REDACTED] used to beat me when he talked to me. I was never touched by [REDACTED] but another detainee that was with me at [REDACTED] said that he was beaten by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stuck a stick in my hole once and threatened me that if I didn't talk he'd do it again, so I said write whatever you want. Whenever we walked out of the bathroom he would kick me on the foot and beat me with a stick. He beat my balls, and put soap and water in my mouth. I'm 90% sure it was [REDACTED] who burned me with a cigarette. They brought electricity wires. I was bleeding from my ear. [REDACTED] was wearing nylon gloves. He had black and gray hair, glasses, and he was wearing a jogging suit. Whenever they wanted to scare me, they would say "do you want me to bring [REDACTED] to put the stick in your hole?" The linguist would ask me that, I've never seen his face. The linguist didn't have an Iraqi dialect. I got here on April 29th. When they took me and [REDACTED] to Taji from [REDACTED], we were put in the trunk of a white Chevy Celebrity. [REDACTED] was put in the trunk of a dark Mercedes. [REDACTED] was riding in one of the cars that were taking us to [REDACTED] because I heard his voice when we got there. There was at least one American with us. The floor of the room that I was in at [REDACTED] was yellow and the walls were pink. I was in Taji for 9 days. They treated me nice in Taji.
