When we dropped off a detaines at that they would use for search and in case they had a big operation, and there was another apparated area in a chain link force with hooths used to hold detainess. It was made out of plywood, 2x4s, and chain link fence. There were no bods. They either sleet in the booth or sleet on the floor, I don't know. I was never there when they slept. When we'd come in at uight you really couldn't see the detainess because you had to look inside. If you did look inside, you could see some of them leaving against the booths, or steeping in a booth, or on the ground. Blackets were provided. They had an interview tent back inside gate 3. It was inside the complex.

I met him when we started to do joint missions. He seemed very pro-Coalition. 
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
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
