The EDF would put them through a review process and either release them to the Iraqi police, or send them on to long term interment at Abu Ghraib. I did personally ask some of these detainees whether they were Jihadists or conducted direct fire attacks, but not in a structured environment. I was never in the interrogation room with the interpreter asking questions. I was present at interrogations for brief periods of time checking on the process. It was not my job to interrogate, but I was periodically present. The interrogation process would have the detainee sitting in the interrogation room, the interpreter and one or two interrogators working through the interpreters. They would prepare SDRs prior to interrogation and ask questions through the interpreter while sitting in plastic scars and collate the information. They would keep him there and try to identify whether he was telling the truth and try to cross-reference with information from other detainees. The TIR would show who the primary interrogator was, probably no one cise. There were only 4 people involved in interrogation, and they were either all present or rotating in and out. Interrogators would do interrogations as "nice guys," and if the interrogation was not going as planned, they would ratchet up to be more aggressive, increasing the decible of their voice. We used "Mutt and Jeff," with one of them being assertive, but probably not more than 20 percent of the time. Normally, we would ask and get information, correlate the information, and show the detained where he was lying and then their stories would change. The way we enter a room on target, breaching the door and flonding the

room, the aggressive speed, they are off-kilter from the beginning. Ninety-nine percent of the time if there was an injury it happened at the objective. For good order and discipline, if a detainee was being uncooperative, not adhering to instruction, especially if they were fighting, they were restrained on the ground. I only saw this twice with one detainee and that was with That is one of the reasons we had sand in the pit. Inside the interrogation room uncrevere nover any injuries. We may have left detainees alone with an interpreter for a short period of time but it was not SOP or a matter of course. One interpreter lives in Mosni. We call him When I described the aggressive tone used by interrogators, Bo interpreter was called it never exceeded the level a Seal Instructor would use towards a trainee. The Seal Instructor would be worse. The detaines would sometimes be blindfolded during interrogations. Our interpreters would be masked during interrogations. In the interrogations I witnessed the detainces were unmasked and looking eye to eye with the interrogator. We would tell detainees that we might put word on the street that they had given up information. There were no serious threats of physical harm ever made. None of the detainees ever had an injury other than a small cut or bruise.
