WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

I am the Commander of 2-3 FA. We were at one point located at [REDACTED]. We were there from about the end of May 2003 to the end of April 2004. We were there when [REDACTED] was [REDACTED]. Our relationship with [REDACTED] was great; they were a very professional group. Their house was just outside of our complex. Their house was about 200 meters from the main headquarters. It would take 15 seconds to drive from the [REDACTED] to their house. People didn't really drive back and forth, not unless it was work related. We pretty much walked.

I remember that [REDACTED] is notorious in [REDACTED], particularly for speaking the Coalition with [REDACTED]. The name [REDACTED] is in a lot of statements.

I remember that [REDACTED] never saw her but I remember about [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] was in [REDACTED] in connection with a raid. One thing I remember about one statement, but all the major players said matter of fact, yeah that's where we got our money from. [REDACTED] was great; they came to the gate with her brothers to try to talk her way out of it. Little did she know there were already statements implicating her, and she was detained on the spot. I don't remember how long they were there, maybe one or two days. They were detained in the 2-3 FA detention cell.

They came to [REDACTED]. I think [REDACTED] were working that particular target. They stayed in our detention facility at the Palace. We called it the [REDACTED] facility. Camp was a [REDACTED] facility. The brigades had one in the NSA. The 501st FSB detention facility was the brigade detention facility.

As far as a database, I'm not sure what we have [REDACTED] that time frame. They were [REDACTED] close to the police academy. Our facility is on the opposite end of where our Headquarters is. It is on the opposite end of where the [REDACTED] was.
