WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

I've been the assistant S-2 for 2-3 FA since the middle of October 2003. My responsibilities in domestic operations at 2-3 FA included verifying the paperwork, filling out all the forms required. We ensured that the detainees got food, medicine, and water. We had a roster, every four hours we let them go to the latrine. If they need to go to the latrine before that time, they need to do so. They can get water anytime, MREs and hot show for breakfast, lunch and dinner. They slept in the mess facility but we provided them with blankets, heater and on some occasions coats.

The small detention facility had five "polar boxes" on each side with a heater in the middle, and had a capacity of 10 to 25 individuals. This is where detainees usually stayed. The bigger facility is approximately 20 feet by 20 feet, and has a heater inside. It has wood all around it with one spring of concussion wire. We normally had less than five detainees there at a time. During December we had 63 detainees; we normally did their medical and transferred them to the NSA within four hours.

1. Remember the [redacted] If I'm not mistaken there were five. [redacted] was never caught. We got [redacted] and [redacted] was a financier, she used her family to conduct or guard her money. [redacted] was used for administrative purposes. [redacted] bought weapons and they dispatched them to conduct attacks. They were known for RPG and missile attacks. There were indications that they provided money for IRDA.

_____ was captured during _____ she came to our compound, because she heard we were looking for her and her husband. She came when _____ she went out and came back with _____ They were detained in the small building. They went there for 2 days, but I'm not sure. It wasn't likely that it could've been five. We have 24 hours to transfer prisoners to the USA versus 30 days. The _____ family never felt to go to the GDA team houses. They got interrogated in the interrogator's tent in front of the cell. When the GDA wanted to interrogate somebody they did it in this facility, not at _____ people are always

He is an informant and a good guy, as far as I know. As far as I know he has been a member of the [redacted] since he was in the [redacted] and he has been a member of the [redacted] since he was in the [redacted]. He doesn't speak English. I used mostly the interpreters from the [redacted] to talk to him. He never had access to interrogate detainees from 2-3 FA's detention facility. There's no possibility that he ever had access to detainees. Detainees only would stay on the bus if they were missing. We used it once for people to sleep in. I don't remember if any of the [redacted] stayed on the bus. The bus was functioning, and it was never broken down for a period of time. We just have one bus.

_____ was detained in a raid in a coffee shop near Christmas. _____ was just a drunk guy. He stayed in our facility, and then we transferred him to Brisbane two days later. He passed away after he left the NSA. I'm not sure how he died.
