[REDACTED] MAT MC, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:
 On June 6th, 2004, I interviewed and examined two detainees
 AS per request of Command. Both detainees were cooperative
 and were good historians.

Detainee [REDACTED] a 36 Yr married ^{omit/US} x-military engineer car
 salesman. Arrested by history 24 December in Baghdad.
 Complete handwritten notes on attached and
 authenticates by me as being true and accurate from
 my interview of this detainee.

Summary: States he was beaten at 800000 and
 left prone and punched on left side of
 head causing external and internal bleeding.
 States he was hung by a nail from the
 wall with his hands bound behind his
 back with 1gates. States he was
 lay upon the floor as he returned with
 his hands bound and sodomized with a
 metal "penis" that they "referred to as".
 He also states that his interrogators
 grabbed his testicles with a plastic which
 caused localized pain and bloody discharge
 from his penis for more than a week.
 After being sodomized, he reports his
 underwear had blood everywhere, and
 he has had very painful defecations

examine. This detained exam is notable for left side abdominal and flank tenderness and pain tenderness of the left testis. The only physical findings were obvious laceration scars on his wrists consistent with his history. He also has some anal pain and "feels" need a pain area of breakdown of the skin of the anus and changes consistent with an anal fissure at the 6-o'clock position. Internal exam is [redacted].

Detainee [redacted] -- a 36 Yr Iraqi warren male, ex Iraqi Army Engineer/major. Arrested 04 April 2003 at his home in Baghdad. He was taken to the [redacted] in Baghdad and held for about 16 days.

Summary: States he was beaten with a stick on the bottoms of his feet and hands with lit cigarettes as the doorway of both feet. He was also beaten on his left forearm and punched in right eye and left ear. He also states that they attempted to strangle him but stopped pain to significant injury to his arm. Exam reveals scars of laceration 3 fingers several Right Shoulder & his feet but right arm other areas are normal.
